2 tbsp. margarine 1/4 cup white sugar ½ tsp. salt

1 ½ - 2 cups flour 11/2 cups canned, drained apple slices

1 egg beaten 2 tbsp. brown sugar 1/4 tsp. cinnamon

1/4 tsp. nutmeg 2 tbsp. margarine icing sugar frosting

Measure 3/4 cup warm water in large bowl, stir in 1 teaspoon sugar and dry yeast, let stand 10 minutes, then stir well, meanwhile melt margarine in sauce pan. Stir in sugar and salt, add margarine mixture to dissolved yeast, add egg and 3/4 cup flour to make a stiff batter. Spread batter evenly in greased 9" square pan. Arrange apple slices on top, sprinkle with mixture of brown sugar, cinnamon and

nutmeg. Dot remaining 2 tbsp. margarine over. Cover, let rise in warm place free from drafts, til doubled in bulk, about 1 hour. Bake at 400 deg. F. for 25 minutes or til done. Remove from oven, let stand 10 minutes before removing from


