Fall Programs Photography

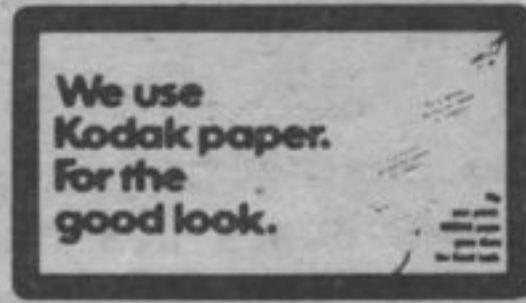
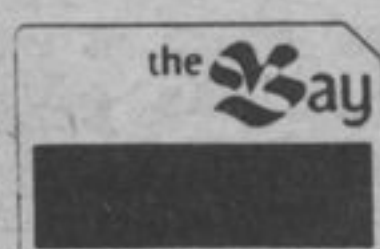

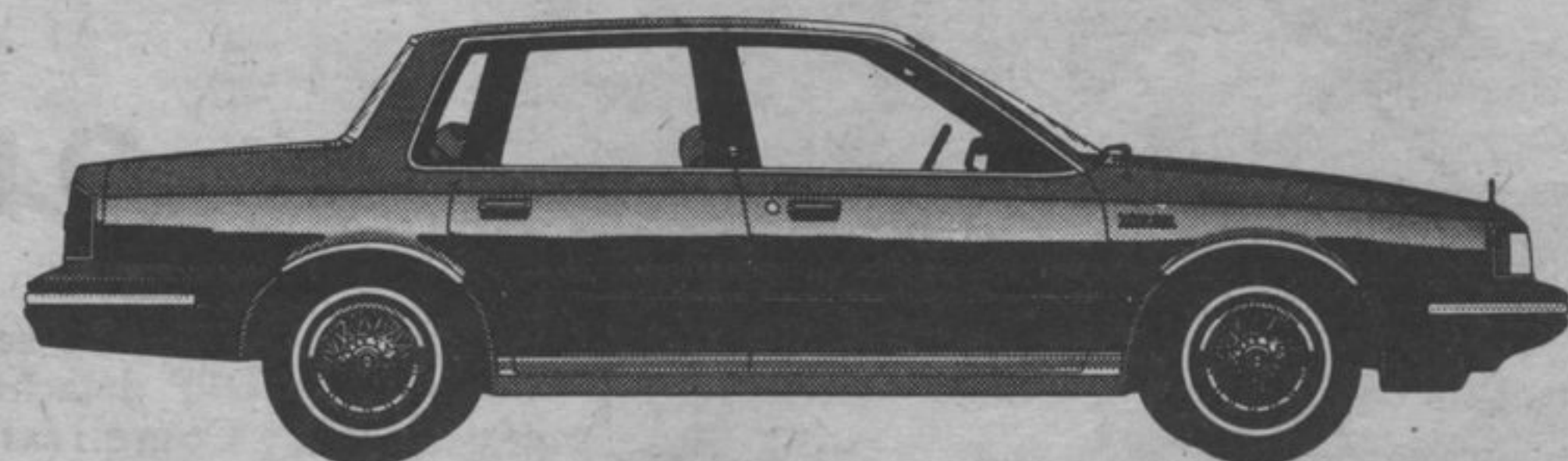
