Mr. Bernier spoke on how Marathon was almost on it's knees six months ago when American Can announced they would close the pulp mill if they could not find a buyer for this operation. Mr. Bernier come to the new sections involved in Marathon, James River-Marathon, and Buchanan Bros. With the new owners of the mill and now the gold mine the future looked much brighter for Marathon.

Mr. Bernier said it was a bit ironic that years ago when he was head of the Ministry of Natural Resources, a wilderness park was talked about for this area because it had no geological significan-

Mr. Bernier said he was pleased with the work that Mr. Ernie Lane and his staff were doing as the co-ordinating committee of all the ministries involved in the Hemlo Project. This would give all ministries a chance to plug-in to the Hemlo situation and this seemed to be working very well.

Mr. Bernier mentioned how his Ministry was responsible for road and highway construction in the north. Tours like this gave them a chance to move around and see the condition of the highways. The Ministry could then pass on funds to improve these roadways. Mr. Bernier said the Ministry of Northern Affairs operated on decisions made by northerners for northerners.
