Remembrance Day Approaches

The Royal Canadian Legion's poppy fund has a three-fold purpose: it provides employment for disabled veterans and their widows, money for veterans' welfare, and a simple but meaningful way to remember approximately 114,000 Canadians who died in the First and Second World Wars and the Korean conflict.

Poppies and wreaths are made at Vetcraft Shops in Toronto and Montreal. About 30 workers are employed at the two plants and another 75 work from their homes. They produce more than 12 million poppies and thousands of wreaths and crosses annually.

"Functions of the Poppy"

Where does the money raised through their distribution go? It could provide bursaries for children of ex-service personnel, or help operate a Legion Service Bureau that assists veterans in making pension claims. It could also be used to operate daycare centres for seniors, or it might help needy ex-servicemen in other Commonwealth or allied

countries. There are as many uses as there are veterans.

Most importatly, wearing a scarlet poppy is a way to remember the thousands of young Canadians who died years ago on the sea, in the air and on foreign battlefields from France and Africa to Korea.

It says we haven't forgotten.
