Canada's National Energy Programme

In order to effectively manage our energy resources, the Government of Canada has developed the National Energy Programme. The programme has three major objectives:

- (1) To develop energy security particularly energy self-sufficiency in oil by 1990.
- (2) To increase the opportunities for Canadians to participate in the oil and gas industry.
- (3) To achieve fair energy sharing and fair energy prices for governments, industry and consumers.

To achieve the objectives of oil self-sufficiency by 1990, Canadians have been encouraged to reduce their use of energy and especially their use of oil. As well, the government has implemented a number of services for consumers to achieve effective energy management.

The Enersave Advisory Service

This service intends to help Canadians reduce the energy consumption in their own homes. Consumers interested in reducing their energy bills can phone the Enersave office and will be sent a questionnaire which will determine the basic characteristics of their individual homes. Once the questionnaire is returned, Enersave will analyze the answers by computer and return the results to the consumer, showing each consumer how they can save energy in their homes. The Canadian Home Insulation Programme

This programme will provide a taxable grant of 60 per cent of the combined materials and labour costs for home insulation up to a maximum of \$500 per house-

hold. To be eligible to participate in this programme the insulation, caulking, weatherstripping and vapour barrier materials must be approved by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (C.M.H.C.) As well, the work must be performed by a Canadian General Standards Board certified contractor to be considered eligible for the labour component of the grant. To determine if your home qualifies for an insulation grant or to obtain more information, you can call the C.H.I.P. office collect at 1-416-789-0581.

The Canadian Oil Substitution Programme

To encourage homeowners and small businesses to convert their heating systems from oil to other sources of energy the C.O.S.P. was designed. This programme provides taxable grants covering 50 per cent of the conversion costs to a maximum of \$800 per unit. To be deemed eligible for this programme, the new heating systems should reduce the building's re-

liance on oil by at least 50 per cent. A new solar system need only provide one-third of the building's heating requirements. If you are considering switching to natural gas or electricity, your local distributor will assist you in providing information on obtaining your grant. If you are considering propane, wood, solar or other energy forms, you should contact the C.O.S.P. office by calling collect at 1-416-789-0581.
