Schreiber Economic Development Seminar

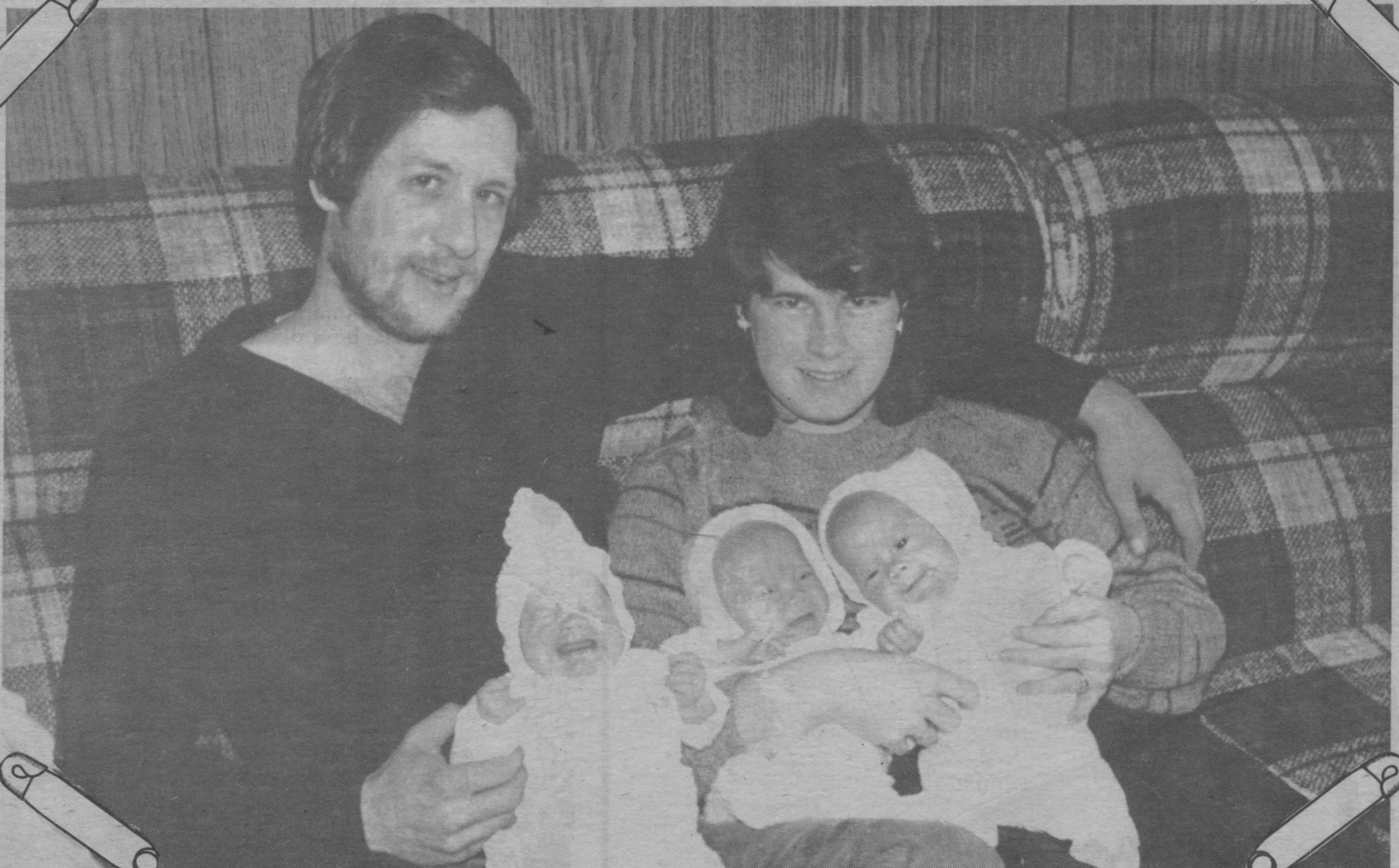
