Now everyone from newborns to senior citizens are covered by Ontario's child restraint and seat belt laws.

purchasing and installing snow-making equipment for its ski hills at Neebing Township, near Thunder Bay. The equipment will make it possible to extend the skiing season by four to six weeks, according to a recently-completed study.

NORDA has also offered a total of \$148,350 to 12 privately-owned tourist lodges in northern Ontario; the funds are all allotted to promotion campaigns to attract more tourists.

NORDA is an \$18.5 million federal-provincial agreement. It is intended to help sustain, expand or diversify the economic base of Northern Ontario by helping finance new or expanded economic activities, making use of local resources, and providing employment for local residents.

Of the \$18.5 million, \$17 million is shared equally by Canada and Ontario. The remaining \$1.5 million is earmarked to provide special assistance to Northern Ontario's status Indians. This amount is shared equally by two federal departments: Regional Economic Expansion (DREE), and Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND).

NORDA ends on March 31, 1984; applications under the agreement must be approved by the management committee prior to that date.
