PLANNING ACT, 1983

NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING AMENDMENT BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHREIBER



TAKE NOTICE: That the Council of the Township of Schreiber passed By-Law 763 on the 8th day of November 1983, under Section 34 of the Planning Act 1983.

AND TAKE NOTICE: That any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the by-law by filing with the Clerk of the Township of Schreiber, not later than the **14th day of December 1983** notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law, describing the lands to which the by-law applies, and a Key map showing the location of the lands to which the by-law applies (or, alternatively, an explanation as to why a Key map is not provided) are attached. The complete by-law is available for inspection in my office during office hours.

EXPLANATORY NOTE:
 By-law 753, permits the installation of satellite receiving dishes in the residential and other property zones within the Township of Schreiber. The dishes must be placed on private property, in accordance with the front, side and rear allowances of By-law 631, as amended. This amendment applies to the total area of the Township of Schreiber, and therefore, no explanatory map is required.

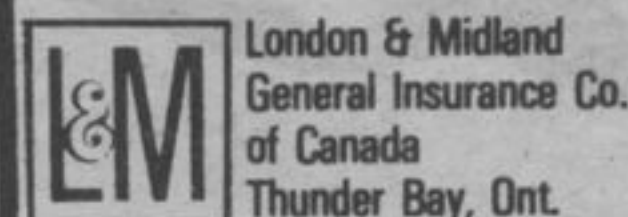
