Reeve Olsson of White River to the Hon. A.W. Pope, Minister of Natural Resources requesting that the Minister reconsider the preparation of a study which will concern the development of the Manitowadge Corner and Hemlo Mining area for both light commercial-industrial and tourist-commercial use. Council indicated its support of the stand taken by White River.

Resolutions were made to pay the following accounts: *General Accounts* - \$50,980.78 and *Water Works Account* - \$7,457.68.

Unfinished Business:

The Clerk was instructed to complete arrangements with the District Mental Health Programme for the use of the upstairs office space. The combined rental of both the downstairs space and upstairs was set at \$400. Council agreed to provide a new floor covering for the area.

Council reviewed proposals from various con-

sulting firms concerning the provision of services for the Housing Policy Statement Update and it was resolved that Anderson & Associates be hired to prepare the statement update at the cost of \$7,056.00, and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign an agreement/contract providing for this.

Resolutions were passed for the following by-laws:

(1) that by-law 754 to amend 622 (parking) in respect to times of parking for snow removal and parking near intersections be given 1st, 2nd and 3rd reading.

(2) that by-law 755, a by-law to declare certain lands in the municipalities required for municipal purposes be given 1st, 2nd and 3rd reading. This by-law certifies that a parcel of land, near CP Railway right of way is required to provide additional lands in the event, the resurvey of the R-271 area required adjustments.

(3) That by-law 756 a by-law to authorize the sale of part 1 of reference plan 55-R-5445 to

Mrs. G. Smith in exchange for the whole of part 3 of the same plant, be given 1st, 2nd and 3rd reading and that the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign any pertinent papers.

It was noted by Reeve Fischer that the Ministry of Revenue will present to Council an impact study concerning the implementation of section 63-86; in the township of Schreiber and that all Councillors who are available, should attend.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 p.m. J-11
