On hand for the workshop were Larry Zack from T.V. Ontario and his assistant Mary Lynn McCauley, who is also putting together a Bicentennial brochure on T.V. Ontario. He provided them with a look into people's attitudes and showed a series of film clips on "Where we were" (centuries ago) and "How we got here." in regards to what has happened in the past and how we have modernized our systems in preparations for the future to come.

Efforts being made to caution students

The Addiction Research Foundation, Education Resources Division, is making a concentrated effort to caution Ontario students about the use of the three drugs students report using most frequently - alcohol, tobacco and cannabis.

Student-reported frequency of drug use is based on the A.R.F.'s latest province wide survey on alcohol and drug use among Ontario students.

Each of the three packages includes a videotape, accompanying story booklet and user's guide. Packages will be distributed to the schools this year.

The three packages are "The Score on Can-

nabis"; "Me and My Friends and Our Booze"; (for ages 12-17) and "Butt-It-Out" (designed for ages 6 to 9).

These packages were developed in consultation with teachers and alcohol/drug educators and in co-operation with the Ministries of Health and Education. The topics represent important areas of concern to young people, teachers, and parents. The packages are part of the Foundation's comprehensive plan to improve public awareness on drugs and alcohol throughout the 1980's.

The Foundation will make these packages available to boards of education throughout the province.
