## New testing lab for L.U.

## Grants for landfill improvement sites

Ontario municipalities will be receiving current grants of \$500,000 from the Environment Ontario Waste Improvement programme.

Since the programme started up, in 1977, grants totalling \$3.2 million have been given to various municipalities for studies on landfill sites and for improving and upgrading or closing of such sites. The objective of the programme is to provide financial assistance to municipalities for studies on landfill sites and for improving and upgrading or closing of such sites. The objective of the programme is to provide financial assistance to municipalities, especially smaller ones, to relieve the burden imposed on them in meeting the standards required for the safe disposal of municipal waste.

Today, municipal landfill sites are a far cry from the traditional dumps used for the uncontrolled disposal of waste up to 15 years ago. The selection and the operation of a modern landfill site must conform to many strict specifications designed to protect the environment and the health of the people of Ontario.

The work done on closed sites, with the support of the Ontario Waste Management Improvement Grants, includes activities such as

grading, fencing, seeding and the installation of gas vent pipes.

In operating landfill sites, the funds are used to improve access roads, fences and surface run-off drainage systems and for hydrogeological, gas migration and other related studies.

The Fire Department Advisory Committee then recommended that the Township consider the purchase of property on Ontario St. The Fischer property has one empty lot plus the lot with the residence. There is also a possibility of combining either the empty lot or the used lot with property on either side. This of course would require a zoning by-law amendment and preliminary investigation by the Property Committee.

The Committee agreed to suggest to Council and make a recommendation to commence negotiations regarding the acquisition of the Fischer property to be used to construct a new Fire Hall. It was also suggested as an alternative, that Council consider the replacement of the Town Hall with an entirely new facility that would accommodate the Fire Department, the Library and other municipal services.

### notice : decision

Decision CRTC 84-72; Lakeshore Community Television Ltd., Terrace Bay, Ont. In Decision CRTC 83-757, the CRTC announced that it approved an application to add the carriage of the signals of KOMO-TV Seattle, WJBK-TV, WTVS and WDIV Detroit, to be received via satellite from the CANCOM network, on the broadcasting receiving undertaking serving Terrace Bay.

The licensee had also proposed to increase the maximum monthly subscriber fee from \$15 to \$19 to cover the costs of providing the above noted services. The Commission authorized an increase in this fee to \$18.44 which it considered was justified based on the guidelines for rate increases associated with the addition of the CANCOM "3 plus 1" U.S. signals, set out in Public Notice CRTC 1983-109. Further, in line with such notice, the Commission deferred its decision on the remaining portion (\$0.56) of the proposed increase until it had assessed this additional amount.

Based on the financial information submitted by the licensee, the Commission has determined that the \$0.56 increase is not justified based on the costs to be incurred or the provision of the CANCOM services, and it is, accordingly, denied. Q. Where may I read CRTC documents? A. The "Canada Gazette", Part 1, contains the complete texts of the CRTC documents, in both official languages. It may be read at CRTC offices and at reference libraries, or bought in single copies at bookstores carrying government publications. CRTC decisions concerning a licensee may be read at his offices during normal business hours.
