Persons aged 65 years and older who are receiving the Old Age Security Pension and who have little or no other income are eligible to receive an extra payment attached to their monthly Old Age Security Pension cheque. This additional income is provided by the Federal Government through their Guaranteed Income Supplement Program. The supplement is intended to help support retired persons who have little or no additional income.

atically receive an application for the Guaranteed Income Supplement, and provided they qualify for the supplement, the Federal Government will forward a renewal application each year.
This month, persons who received the supplement last year will be receiving their renewal applications. These renewal applications must be filled out and sent to the Federal Government as soon as possible. However, to ensure accuracy, it is best to wait until all income information slips are received before completing your application.

In order to receive the supplement an application for benefit must be completed by an individual when reaching age 65 and every year thereafter. The amount of supplement that a person receives is based on their marital status and yearly income. Basically any monies received are considered income for Income Tax purposes must be reported when applying for the Guaranteed Income Supplement. Examples of income that must be reported on the supplement applications include: Unemployment Insurance Benefits, net interest received from banks, bonds or mortgages, net dividends and/or net capital gains or losses, net rents from property, net income from self employment, income from other sources (i.e. alimony, trust funds, Registered Retirement Savings, etc.).
Persons who have recently reached their 65th birthday will auto-

If, after receiving all your income information slips, you require assistance in completing your application, or if you have not received your application, contact the Northern Affairs office.
If after filing your application your marital status and/or financial circumstances change, the Federal Government must be notified to ensure that you will receive the supplementary income appropriate to your situation. If you require assistance, Northern Affairs can help.
