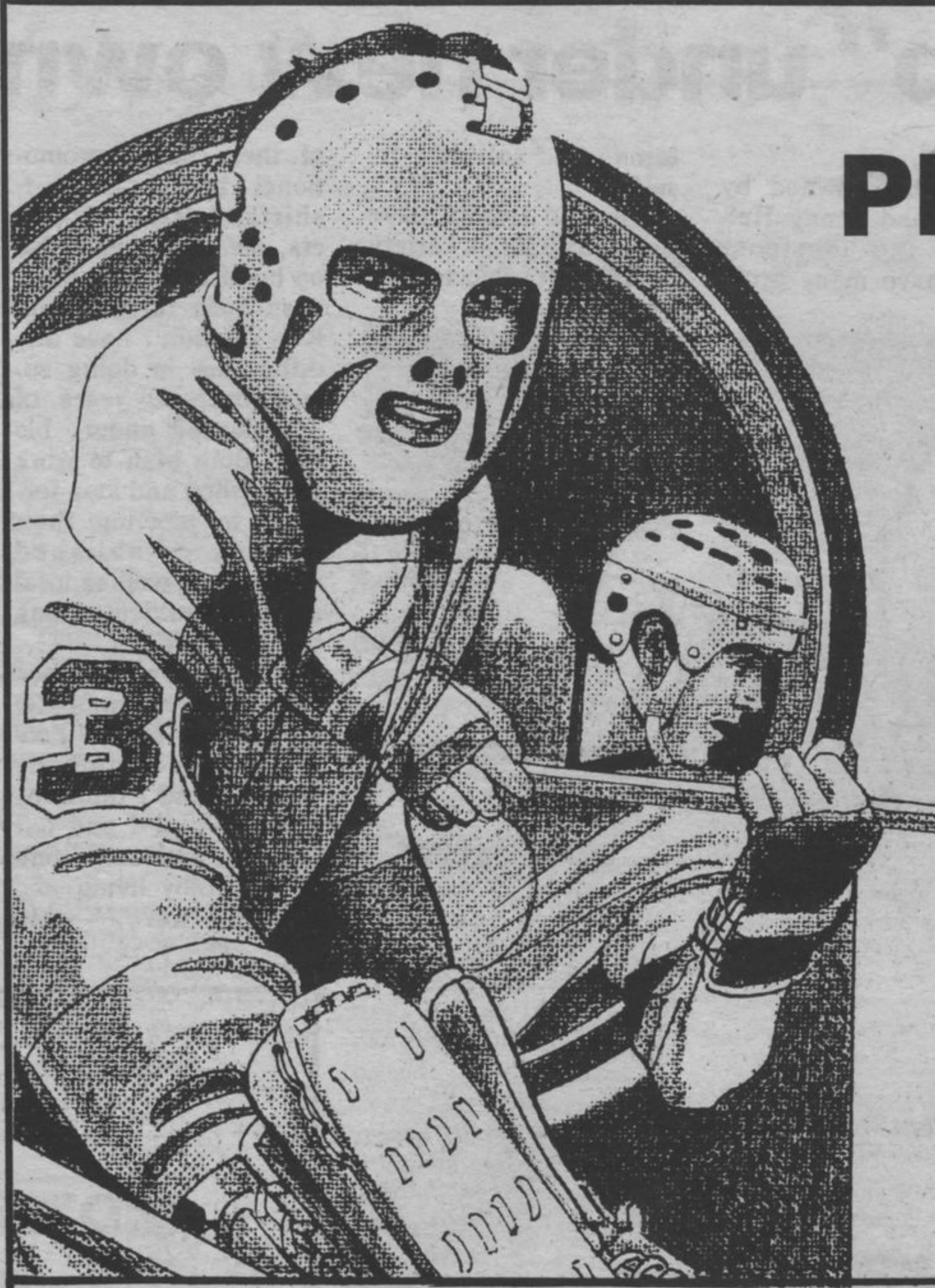
Bridge was played and winners were Eva Gordon and M. Inatdo. The next meeting will be the 18th of May. The Home Bingo will start for May.
