Youth Sports and Fitness Festival
This is the year of the festival! The Multi-Cultural on June 9th, the 25th Anniversary from June 25th to July 7th

and now a sports and fitness festival sponsored by the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation (Bi-Centennial) scheduled for July 16th - 20th.
The week long festival will offer young people a unique and interesting summer experience at no cost. Boys and girls 9-11 years of

age will participate and learn the basic skills of six sports: running, jumping, bicycling, throwing, catching and striking. As the week progresses, individual improvements on these skills will be measured through a series of activities which include a mini obstacle course and strengthathon that will challenge the participants fitness level.

Awards will be presented to everyone who completes the program. In addition, 1 boy and 2 girls in each age category will represent Terrace Bay at the area Festival in Geraldton. From Geraldton, one team will be selected to advance to the Provincial event to be held in Centennial Park in Etobicoke on the weekend of August 25-26. Any child aged 9-11 will be eligible.
