Now that you've had a serious look at your abilities and qualifications, and have a realistic idea of what kinds of jobs you can do, the next step is to get into action. Start reading the newspaper for Want Ads, talk to friends and family acquaintances about possible job openings. Be sure to register at your nearest Canada Employment Centre for Students (Multi-Pur-

pose room in the Rec Centre).

Talk to your Student Placement Officer; there may be a few job openings you haven't heard about yet.

Just remember, having registered is only the first step towards finding a job. Get out there and meet prospective employers. Ask them about possible job vacancies. If you can prove to the employer that you are eager to work, you will be a step ahead of any other possible employee.
