Summer Youth Sport and Fitness Festival

From June 25th to June 30th the Schreiber Recreation Centre will be hosting a Bicentennial Sports Festival for children 9, 10 and 11

years old.

During this fun filled week these children will be taught six basic skills: running, throwing, kicking, jumping, catching and striking. Following each skill a game will be played using a particular skill. To challenge and improve the participant's fitness level they will go through a series of mini obstacle courses and special events called a "strengthenathon."

The program runs from Monday, June 25 to Friday June 30. Each day begins at 9:00 a.m. and concludes at 4:00 p.m.

Hospital Coverage

On reaching the age of 21, or on marriage, or on becoming fully employed — whichever happens first — a young person normally ceases to be classed as the parents dependent.

An able dependent ceases to be eligible for coverage under the parent's insurance number from the first day of the month following the 21st birthday. To maintain continuous coverage, application should be made to O.H.I.P. within 30 days of the

21st birthday. Applications are available from Northern Affairs. In the case of marriage, a dependent ceases to be eligible for coverage under the parents insurance from the first day of the month following marriage. Steps must be taken within 30 days of marriage to change your insurance to family coverage.

Those that are applying for new coverage through non-group enrolment must now provide a copy of a document pertaining to resi-

dency status. For example - a returning Canadian or from another Canadian province, or Ontario resident must provide a Canadian Birth certificate or Canadian citizenship certificate. A landed immigrant, returning immigrant (from outside Canada), landed immigrant from another Canadian province or territory must attach a copy of Canadian immigration or returning resident permit.

Under certain circumstances, a resident may arrange to continue in O.H.I.P. while living temporarily outside of Ontario. O.H.I.P. would have to be advised of the details stating reason for absence and its expected duration.

If you leave Ontario to take up residence, elsewhere, you may continue your O.H.I.P. coverage until other health insurance coverage becomes effective, or for up to four months after you leave Ontario - whichever comes first.
