Wild Rice Advisory Service

The Lakehead University wild rice research unit has announced it will provide a free advisory service to improve rice management techniques in Northern Ontario. This service is part of the five year research program funded by the Ontario Ministry of Northern Affairs.

Northern Affairs Minister Leo Bernier says he hopes the service will help Northern growers boost wild rice production. "I think there is great potential for wild rice as a cash crop in Northern Ontario."

This summer, biologists from the program will visit growers and potential investors in the industry, offering technical advice and free soil testing. The biologists will also visit rice producing lakes and lakes with potential for rice.

Lakehead biology professor Dr. Peter Lee, head of the research program, says lectures will also be given to groups interested in the possibilities of wild rice.

Lee adds there will be a wild rice field day next summer to explain wild rice management to the public.
