# Parents may be Prosecuted for Child's Truancy

Habitual truancy will no longer be an offence under the Education Act for a pupil but refusal to obey a court order to attend school may be dealt with as contempt of court. Parents may continue to be prosecuted for failing to cause their child to attend school.

The chance was included in amendments to the Education Act introduced by Education Minister Dr. Bette Stephenson, which follows the passing of the federal Young Offenders Act and the repeal of the Juvenile Delinquents Act.

Under the new amendments a school board may initiate a school attendance proceeding in the family division of a provincial court. A breach of a court order from such proceedings could lead to the offender, the child or the parent, being charged with contempt of court.

Previously, parents who refused to send their child to school could be fined up to \$100 and the child who refused to attend school could be declared a juvenile delinquent under the Juvenile Delinquents Act.

Dr. Stephenson said that it will be up to the personnel of a school board to decide whether to prosecute a parent or to initiate a school attendance proceeding against the child. Under the amendment family counselling and treatment may be recommended to help remove the cause of the truancy.

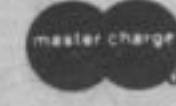

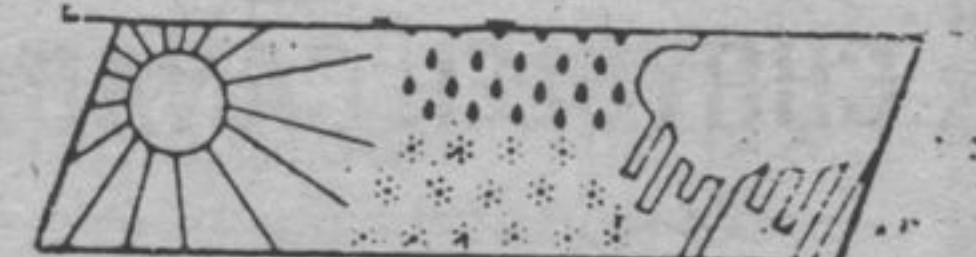
