ers in the area with the Jackfish Tunnel Project. This boat tunnel runs under the CPR overpass that separates Jackfish Lake from Lake Superior. The purpose of the tunnel is to give boaters access between the two lakes.

Over time, the tunnel had become clogged with rocks and debris. Workers hired by the Jackfish Boating association with NEIP funding, cleared out the rocks and reinforced the tunnel with steel and wood beams. The project cost approximately \$7500 and employed six people.

For the naturalists, the tunnel offers a chance to see a rather unique fresh water phenom-

ena. A small tide flows through it between Jackfish Lake and Lake Superior. This is a local occurrence caused by the varying water levels of the two lakes. For example, if rainfall is heavy in the large region of the Lake Superior drainage basin, Superior's water level rises and water flows from it through the tunnel to Jackfish Lake. If local rainfall raises Jackfish's water level then the tide flows from it to Superior.

Jackfish Lake is a man made lake; created by construction of the CPR overpass which separated the former Lake Superior bay and made it into an individual body of water. The common link between the tunnel and trail projects is

that both provide access to the site of the CPR historical marker. The history buff has a choice of boating or hiking to see a part of Northern Ontario's history.

Put these two projects together and an exciting picture is formed: history, boating, camping, hiking, wildlife watching and cross-country skiing. With prospects of tourism and wilderness experiences for the price of \$17,500; it's been a bargain for Jackfish.
