## Mission at Holy Angels

There will be a week-long Redemptorist Mission at Holy Angels Church in Schreiber beginning October 13. The fundamental thrust of this week of mission is to proclaim the reign of God and invite response. This response encourages and strengthens community.

The mission team will begin by preaching at all parish masses the weekend of the thirteenth and the mission proper lasts from Sunday night until Thursday night. Each service is about an hour long with a discussion after.

On Wednesday there is a special celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation and Thursday is concluded with the Eucharist.

The two fathers who will be leading the mission are Fr. Darrell McGinn, C. Ss. R. and Fr.

Michael Brehl, D.Ss.R. Father Darrell is a Maritimer from Saint John, N.B. He was ordained in 1971, and spent his early years of priesthood in Newfoundland preaching missions and retreats and working with the poor.

In 1974 he came to Toronto to work with students studying for the priesthood. At that time Father Darrell also began graduate studies in Scripture and received his doctorate in 1982.

He also brings a lively interest in music to his work as a Redemptorist.

Father Mike and his six brothers and sisters grew up in Toronto. After graduating from the University of Toronto, he joined the Redemptorists.

Upon completing his theology studies in 1979,

Father Mike worked in a large parish in St. John's Newfoundland for four years. Ordained a priest in 1980, he became involved in youth retreats and adult education.

During his off-hours, he enjoys a game

of squash or cards and loves to win! In June of 1983, Father Mike returned to Toronto to join the Mission Team.

The Holy Angels mission begins Sunday evening October 14 at 7:30 p.m. with morning Mission Mass at 10:00 a.m. Mon., Tues., Wed., and evening sessions at 7:30 p.m. Mon., Tues., Wed., and Thurs.

Discussion will follow the evening missions over coffee served in the Parish Centre.

A Mission marks a time of special Gospel preaching and intense prayer held periodically in Catholic congregations. People of all denominations along with those who have no church affiliation are welcome as well.

## PCB Destruction

Ontario is going public with a draft regulation on proposed mobile destruction of PCBs. A Commission of Inquiry has been appointed by the Government of Ontario to investigate public reaction to the question of mobile destruction of PCBs. Mrs. Mary Munro, of Burlington, is chairman, assisted by Robert Eisen, Q.C., of Toronto, and James Britnell, of Goderich. All are members of the Environmental Assessment Board. The hearings at which presentations by members of the public are to be made, will commence in Toronto on November 5 and will continue in other locations as necessary to ensure that all avenues have been explored by the Commission.

PCBs have been widely used throughout Ontario; improper handling and disposal may present hazards to

health and to the natural environment. Although PCBs are no longer produced in Canada and their continued use is

regulated, the challenge of proper disposal remains. At present there are no licensed continued on page 10

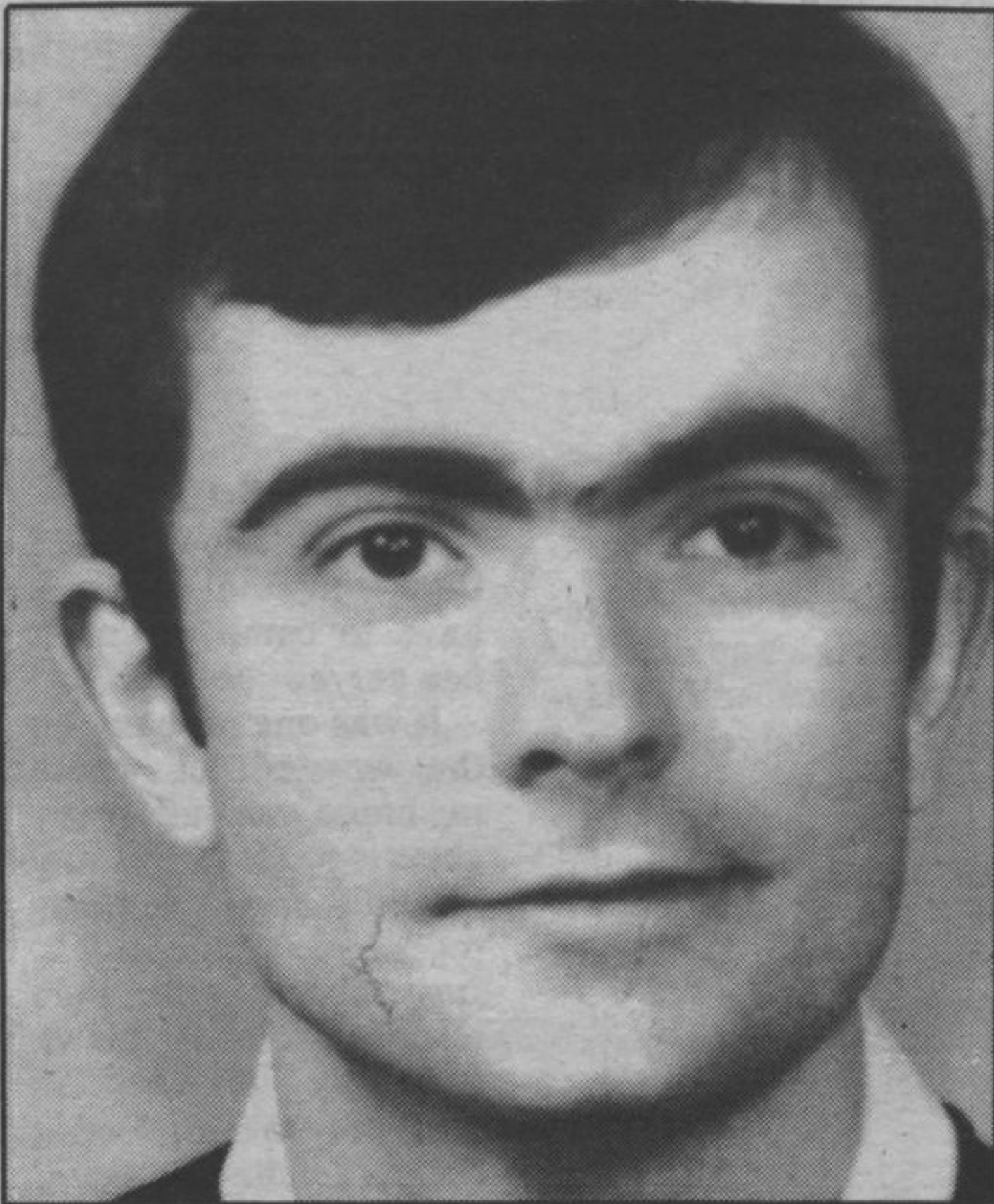
