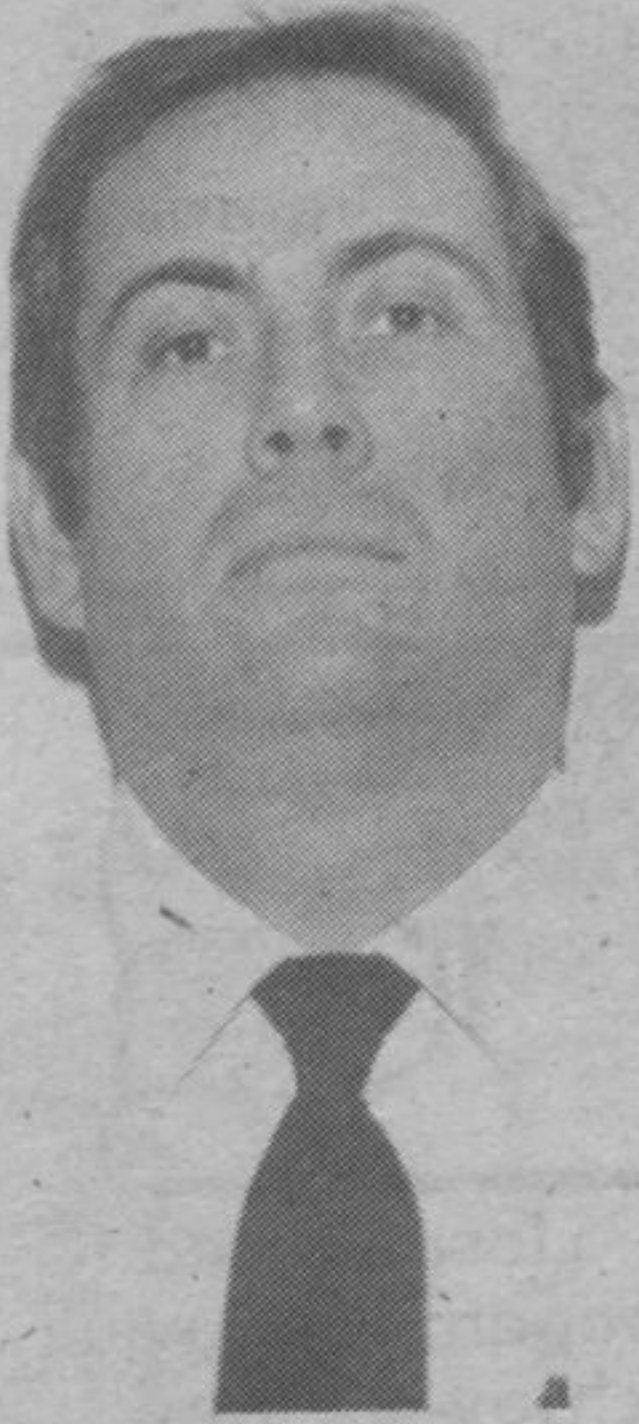
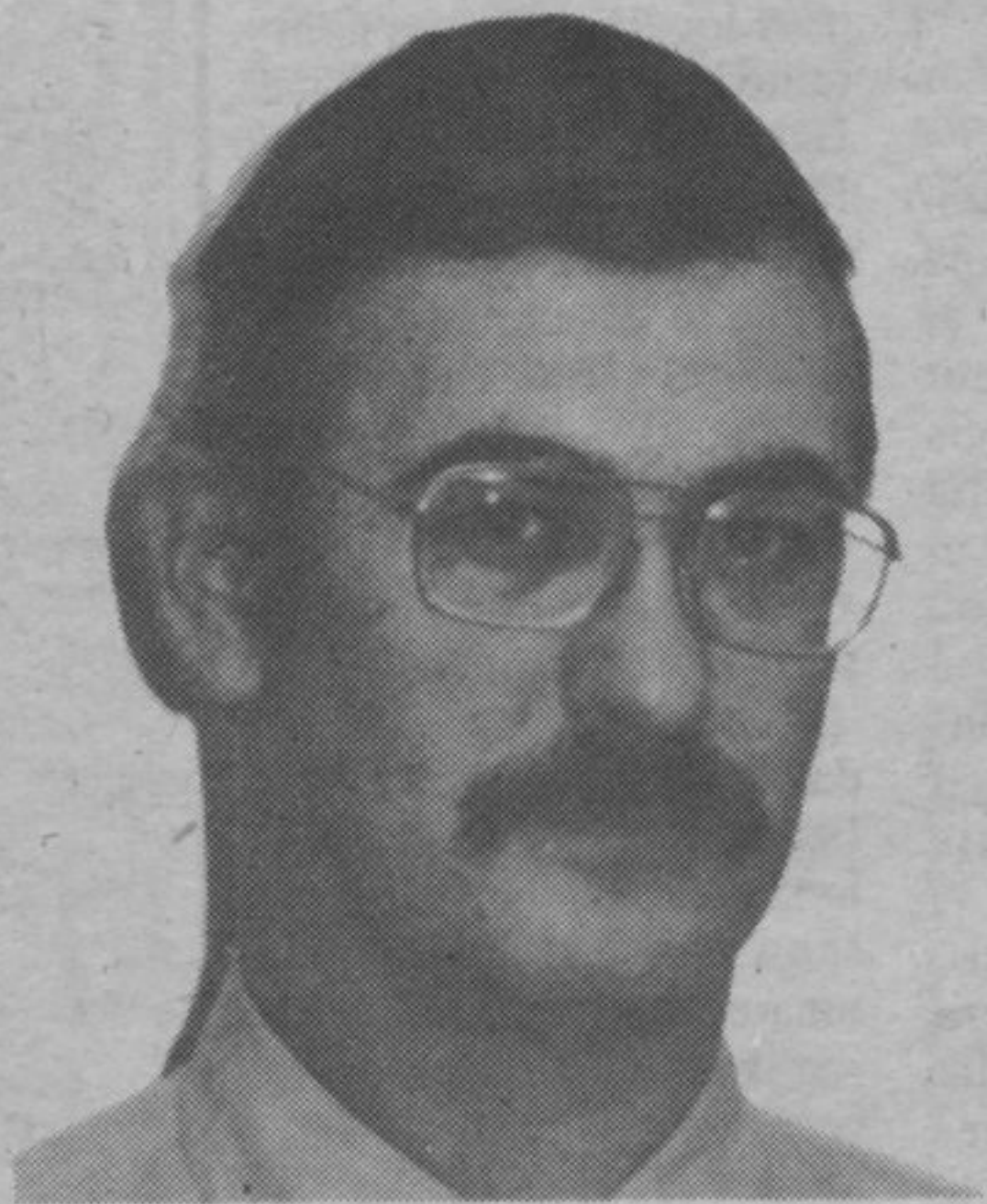

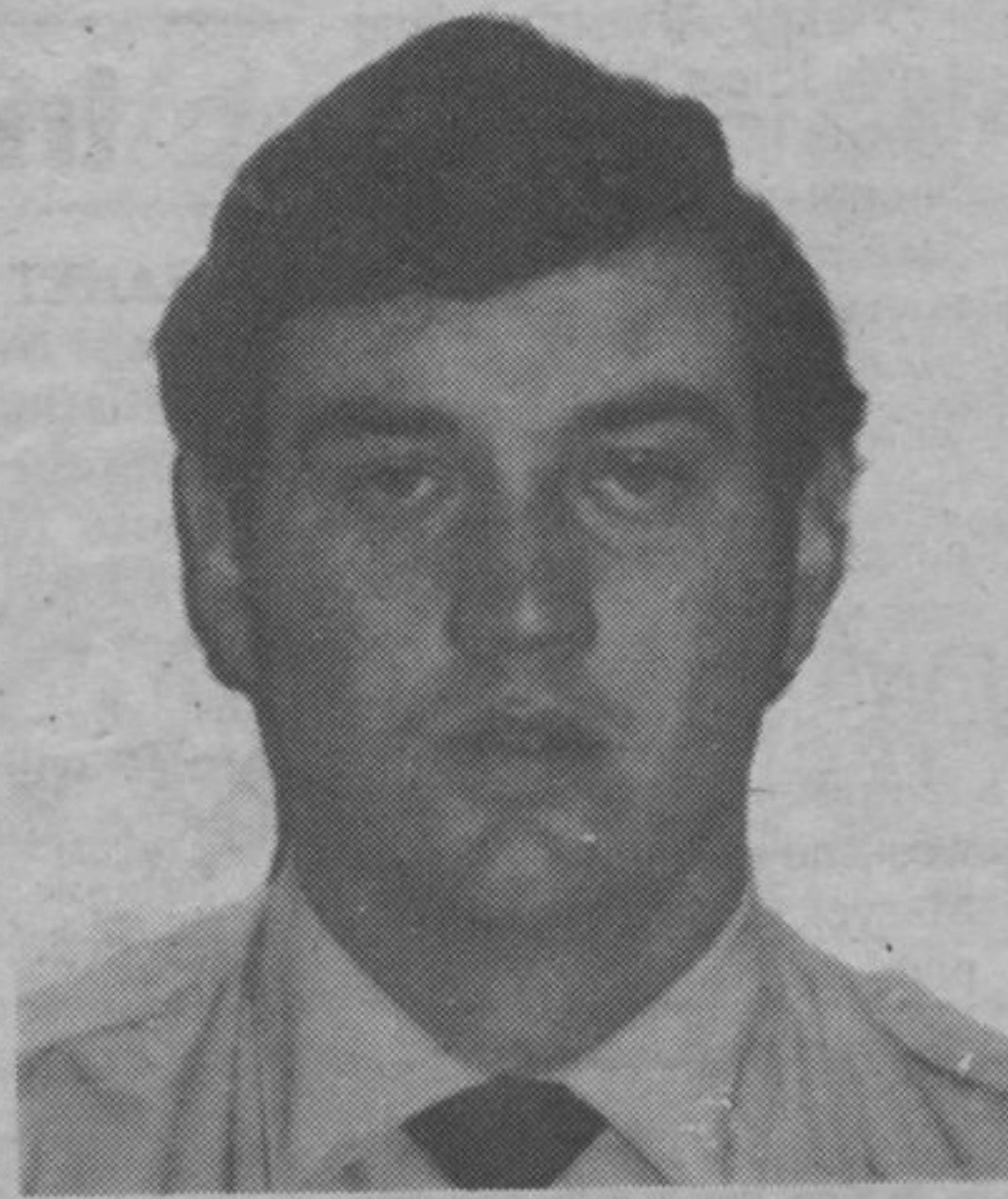

YOUR HOME AND CAR
