Are You Still There?

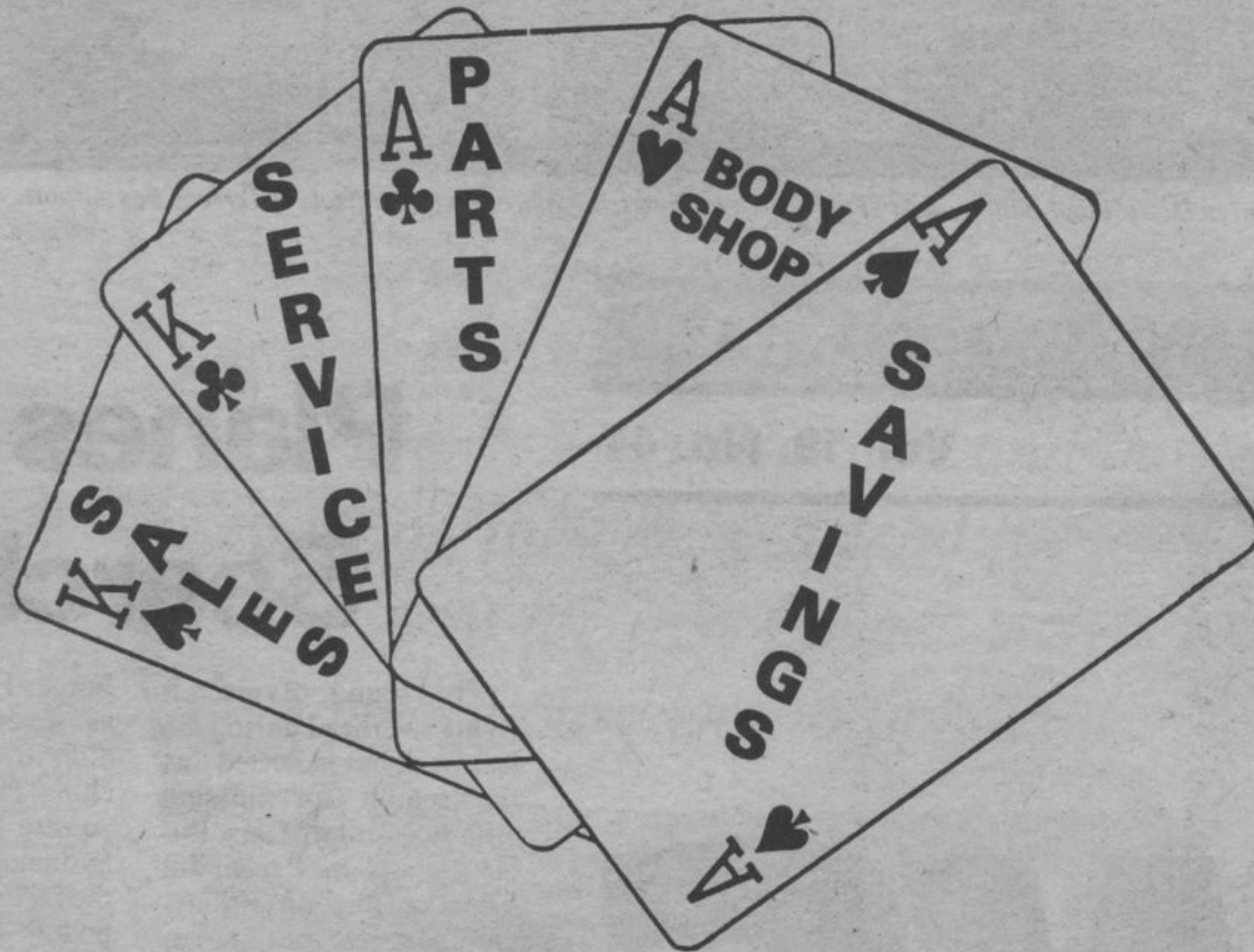

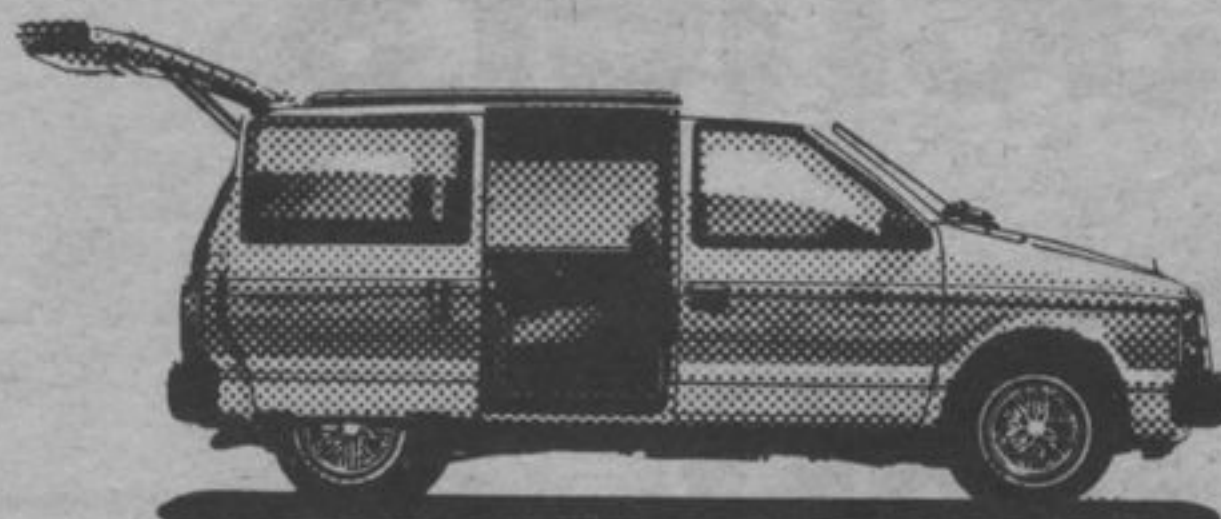
