# Moose hunter

Later this month, the Ministry of Natural Resources will be mailing out a post card questionnaire to most moose hunters who received an adult validation tag in the 1984 moose draw. The purpose of the questionnaire is to obtain a fast and accurate estimate of the number of bulls and cows harvested in each Wildlife Management Unit this fall. This information will help to determine the number of validation tags that will be issued for each WMU in the 1985 moose hunt.

All hunters are asked to fill out the card and return it to the MNR as soon as possible. Accurate information is very important. For example, if hunters do not report kills, the total harvest would be under-estimated. This would result in too many validation tags being issued for 1985, and the herd would decline. This reduction in the herd may not be detected until the next aerial survey which usually occurs every three years. At that time much more restrictive measures would be required if we are to double the herd by the year 2000.

Some hunters will also receive the longer provincial mail survey form. Please fill it out as well, because it provides more detailed informa-

Hunters are also reminded to bring in the lower jaw of their moose, in exchange for an embroidered moose crest. The jaws provide information on the age structure of the kill for use by wildlife mana-

It should be emphasized that shooting a moose in 1984 does not reduce hunter's chances of obtaining a validation tag in 1985. Success in the 1985 draw is determined by whether or not the hunter received a validation tag in 1984. Hunters who applied for a validation tag in 1984, but were not picked, will be selected first in 1985 if they apply in the same WMU. If tags remain, new applicants to the WMU and hunters who obtained a tag in 1984 will be selected.

Accurate harvest information from the mail surveys is essential for the success of the new management moose program. Only by working together can hunters and wildlife manaprovide more moose and more hunting opportunities in the future.
