## Terrace Bay

Several tickets were issued for parking violations under the Township By-laws.

Officers attended one Domestic.

On two separate occasions officers attended the Red Dog regard-

ing a disturbance. In each case a person was charged under the Trespass To Property Act.

Assistance was given to the Nipigon O.P.P. regarding a motor vehicle accident.

One motor vehicle accident was investigated

resulting in the driver being charged with Fail To Report An Accident under the Highway Traffic Act.

Three occurrences of Wilful Damage are still under investigation.

Several people have been warned regarding

improper placement of Val tags on licence plates.

It should be noted that charges will be laid con-

cerning expired and improper placement of Val tags. It is the responsibility of all vehicle owners to be aware of

the laws regarding the Val tags.

Citizens should also note that with the coming of the Holiday Sea-

son, more frequent roadside checks will be made to ensure safe driving on the roads for all concerned.

## OPP kept busy

Motor vehicle accidents occupied much of the time of officers at Schreiber detachment as a total of 10 were investigated from the beginning of the month.

The most serious sent a 25 year old to hospital with serious hand and head injuries. Robin Moore of Schreiber was operating a 1983 Mustang east bound on highway 17 at Billy Lake hill when he lost control and rolled over in the south ditch.

On Dec. 12, 1984, three persons contributed the wearing of seat belts from causing serious injury when Kenneth Maskell age 30 of Calgary was unable to control a 1976 Ford PU towing an 18' leisure trailer. The vehicle struck the guide rails and went over an embankment 2 miles west of Pays Plat.

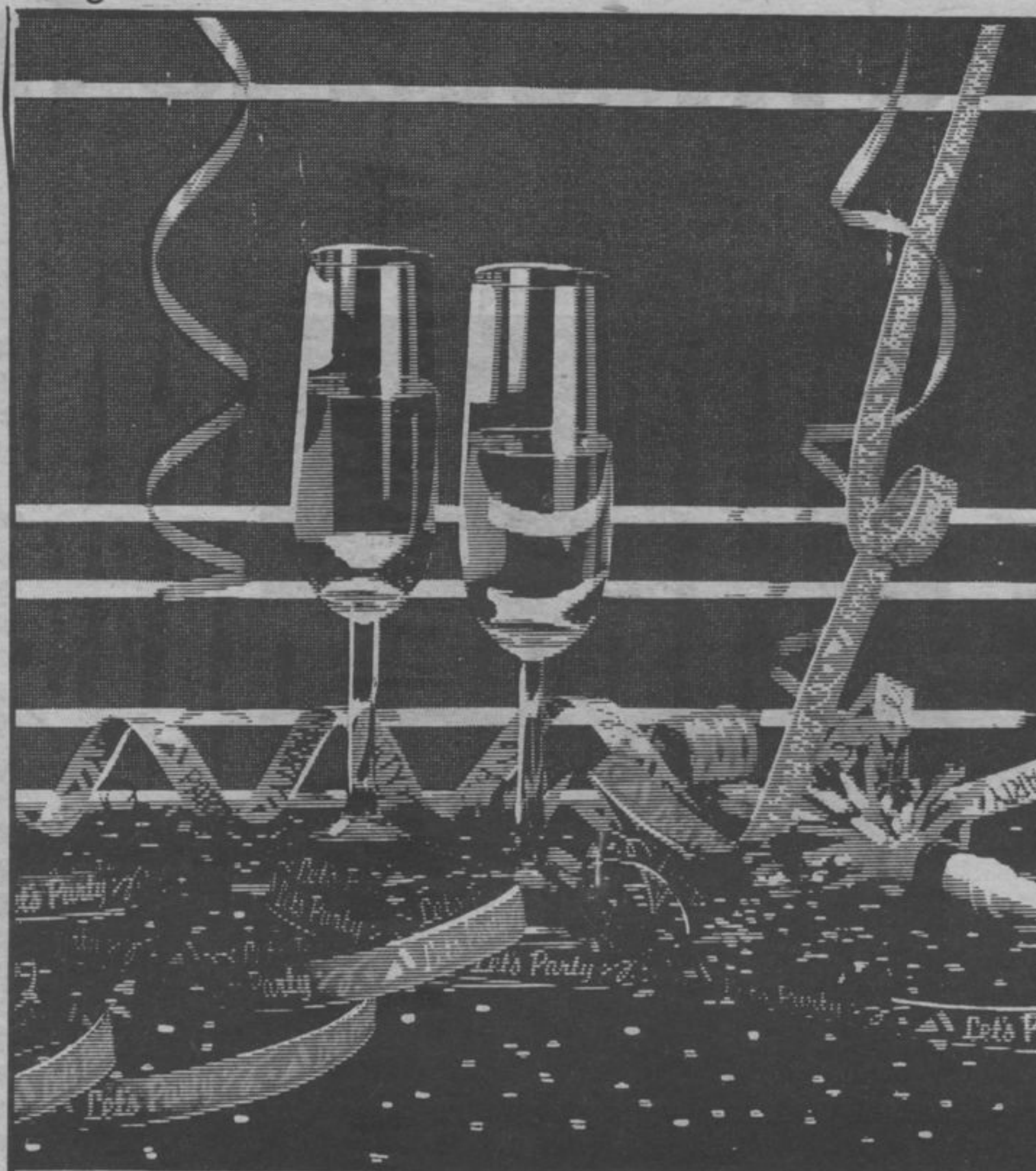
Effective January 1, 1985, the duty of persons involved in accidents changes as the damage value is increased from \$400.00 to \$700. Sec. 173(1) of the Highway Traffic Act will now read "Every person in charge of a motor vehicle who is directly or indirectly involved in an accident shall, if the accident results in personal injury or in damage to property apparently exceeding \$700.00, report the accident forthwith to the nearest provincial or municipal police officer and furnish him with such information concerning the accident as may be required by the officer.

The \$400. limit still applies to accidents involving snowmobiles. There are no provisions for the reporting of accidents in the Off Road Vehicle Act.

During the month of December increased emphasis is placed on the drinking driver.

Increased checks of vehicles in the detachment area have identified 25 suspect vehicles. Eight drivers were given Alert checks and 7 licences were suspended for a 12 hour period. If you plan on drinking this Christmas season, Don't plan on driving.

These checks will continue for the remainder of the year.
