On Dec. 12, 1984, three persons contributed the wearing of seat belts from causing serious injury when Kenneth Maskell age 30 of Calgary was unable to control a 1976 Ford PU towing an 18' leisure trailer. The vehicle struck the guide rails and went over an embankment 2 miles west of Pays Plat.

Effective January 1, 1985, the duty of persons involved in accidents changes as the damage value is increased from \$400.00 to \$700. Sec. 173(1) of the Highway Traffic Act will now read .. Every person in charge of a motor vehicle who is directly or indirectly involved in an accident shall, if the accident results in personal injury or in damage to property apparantly exceeding \$700.00, report the accident forthwith to the nearest provincial or municipal police officer and furnish him with such information concerning the accident as may be required by the officer.

The \$400. limit still applies to accidents involving snowmobiles. There are no provisions for the reporting of accidents in the Off Road Vehicle Act.

These checks will continue for the remainder of the year.






