community."

Ken Temple, administrator of the Lakehead Psychiatric Hospital, said, "The new rehabilitation program should contribute to a reduction in re-admissions to the psychiatric hospital and represents a significant step forward in providing mental health services for our community."

The Thunder Bay programs are two of 50 new community mental health programs to be funded by the ministry this year, at an annual cost of \$6.4 million. Eighteen of these are for the treatment of drug or alcohol programs. This will bring the total number of ministry-funded, community mental health programs to 306, with an annual budget for 1984-85 of \$47.5 million.
