

Cook of the Week



Mrs. Fay Figliomeni has lived in Terrace Bay since 1948, moving here with her parents and her four sisters, who have all turned out to be very good cooks.

Fay's husband Jim is half owner of the Schreiber Foodmarket, where Fay spends much time helping out wherever he can in this family business; when she is not in her own kitchen that is.

Fay and her sister-in-law Linda began catering to small functions around town about 10 years ago. They started out catering to the Kinsmen's functions and from there the demand for their services began to grow and grow. Fay enjoys cooking; as she says, "I'd rather cook than clean."

This recipe is her family's favourite cake. Fay found it in a cookbook a few years back but has experimented with it (as she does with all her recipes) and has perfected it, by the

response of all the people who have tasted it.

Banana Dump Cake
 ½ cup shortening
 1½ cups white sugar
 2 eggs

¾ cup mashed ripe banana
 1 cup sour milk (add 2 tbsp. vinegar to milk and let sit 5 min.)
 2 cups flour
 1 tsp. baking soda
 Dump shortening,

sugar, eggs, and bananas into a large bowl; mix. Dump in rest of ingredients, mix well. Bake in greased 8 x 10 loaf pan at 350 degrees for 45-60 minutes.

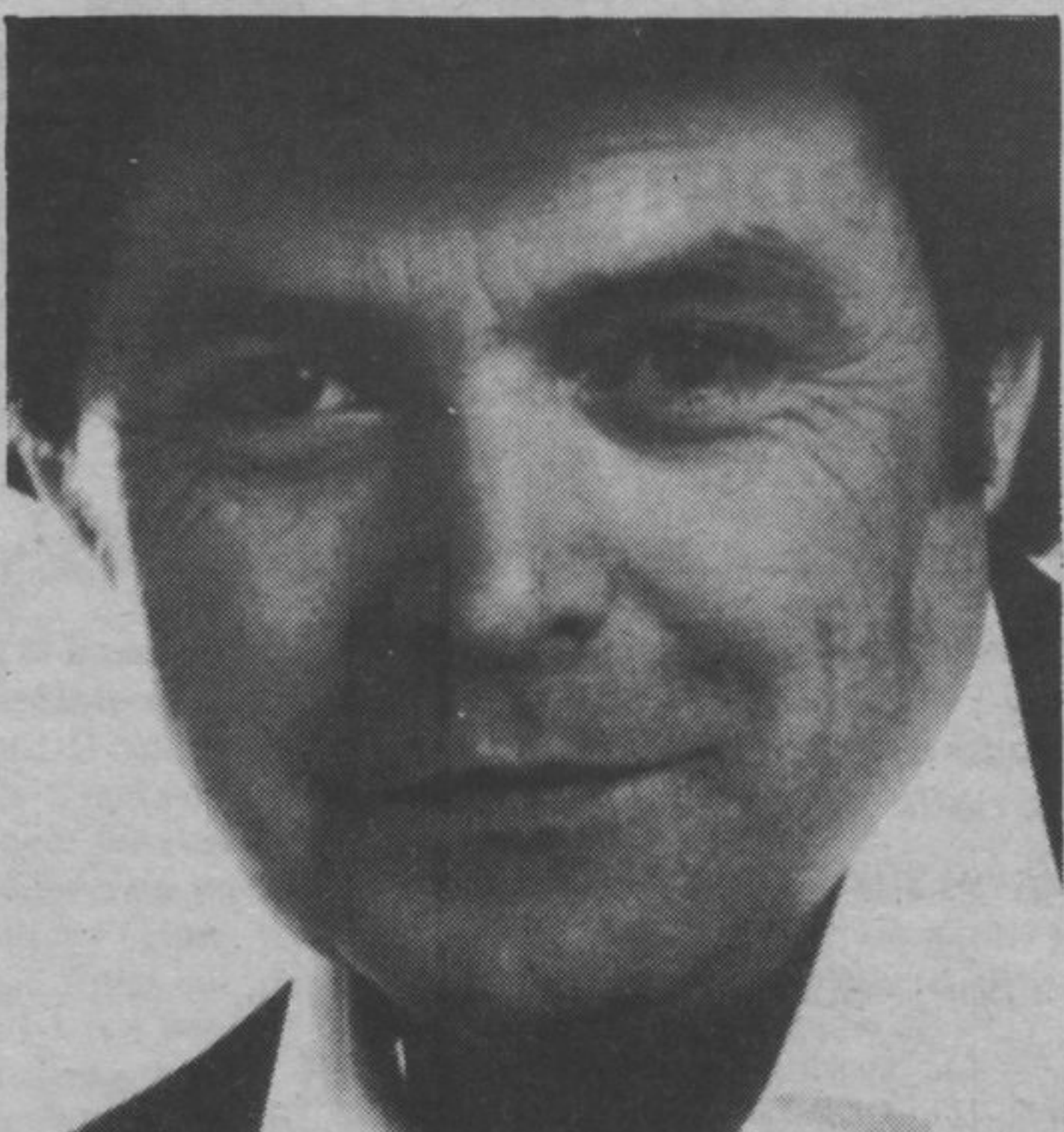
It's Karli, Krystal and Kristine

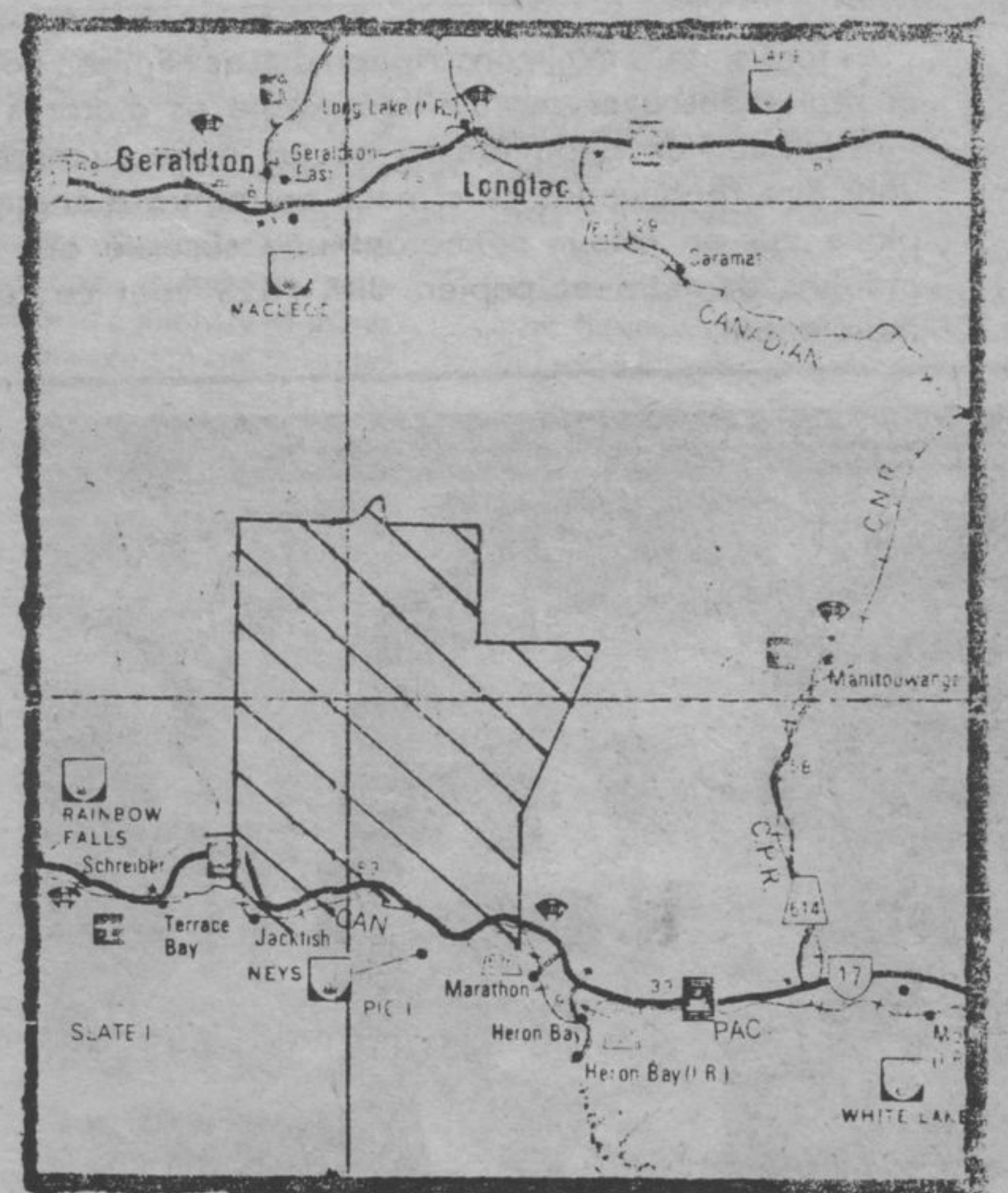
