pages, of the work planned, a budget, a curriculum vitae (resume) and at least two letters of support for the project.

The Canadian Studies Program will have the proposal assessed by a panel of adjudicators representing the various regions of Canada and the two official language groups before giving the applicant the go-ahead. The application deadline is January 1, 1986, and results will be available by mid-March.

The professional and publications experience of the applicant will also be taken into account as well as potential impact of the proposed project on the topic area.

Payment of the award will be in two equal instalments of up to \$5,000 each. The first instalment will be given at the start of the project, which can take up to two years. The second instalments will be given when the project is finished and assessed as being of publishable quality.
