## Best Banana Coffee Cake

½ cup margarine  
 ¾ cup sugar  
 1 ¾ cup all-purpose flour  
 2 teaspoons baking powder  
 ½ teaspoon salt  
 ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon  
 ¼ teaspoon baking soda  
 2 beaten eggs  
 2 ripe medium bananas, mashed (1 cup)  
 ¼ teaspoon milk  
 1 teaspoon vanilla

In a bowl cream butter and sugar together well. Add ¾ cup of the flour, stir just till mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Reserve ½ cup for topping. Stir together remaining one cup flour, baking powder, salt, cinnamon and soda. Stir into batter mixture. Combine eggs, mashed banana, milk and vanilla. Add two dry ingredients, stirring just till mixed. Spread in greased 9 x 9 x 2 in. baking pan. Sprinkle with the reserved ½ cup crumbs mixture. Bake at 375° for 25 to 30 minutes. Makes 9 servings.

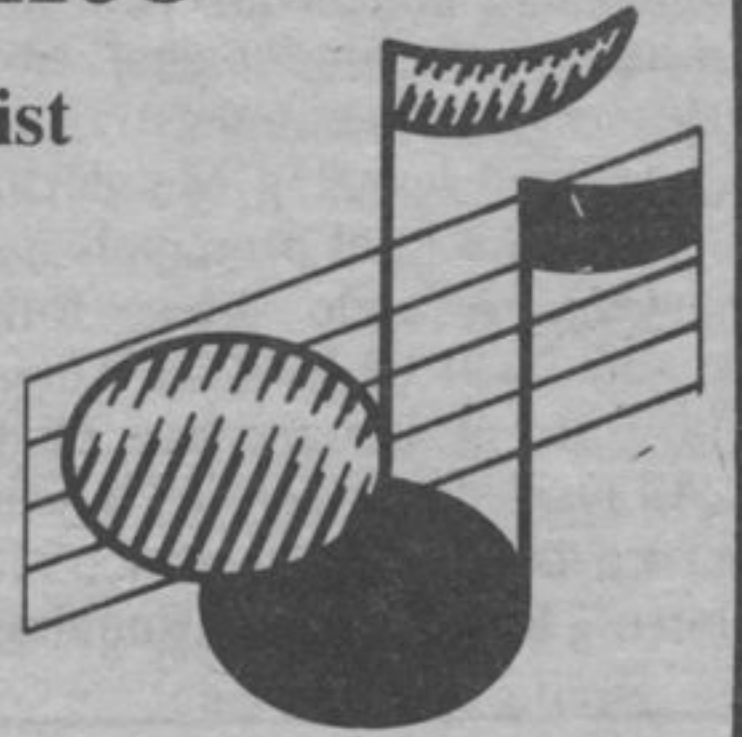
