

# Employment Opportunities

## WANTED.

For possible lifetime contract, a woman for permanent employment as wife. Applicant must be attractive with strong constitution, good teeth and temper, prepared to work with efficiency and flair at love making, child bearing, sewing, cooking, house cleaning and interior decorating. A good knowledge of child and adult psychology, basic nursing, minor house

repairs and a clean driving licence are also required. A degree in Home Economics is not essential, but would be useful.

There will be a few additional duties such as family letter writing, sending Christmas cards, birthday cards and purchase of appropriate gifts for such occasions. Applicants must also be capable of educating the children in table manners and social behavior plus scholastic

coaching as required.

A good memory is a must, in order that all previous year's records and expenses etc., can be produced at a moment's notice. All bills and sales slips, etc., must be removed from pant pockets or top of drawers and properly filed for income tax purposes.

Applicant must take care of all children's dental and vaccination appointments, as well as possess highly developed ESP in order to know when to have meals ready and for how many. She must be able to drive snowmobiles, motor boats, and assist with snow shovelling, etc.

Hours are flexible, but will normally be from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week. Although these hours may often be extended upon demand, applicant is however, assured that the seven days per week will not be extended, as no way has yet been found to do so.

Holidays will be granted each year but the household duties and care of the children must be carried on during the vacation. Any hobbies or pass times may be pursued during leisure

time, as long as regular duties are not neglected, such as gardening, lawn mowing, and canning.

Household allowance will vary according to the income. This depends a great deal on weather, markets, strikes, etc. There will be no salary, sick leave, social security or pension plan attached to this position. Room, bed and food will be provided free, so long as the incumbent cleans the room, shares the bed and cooks the food. The employer has privilege of terminating this employment at any time should better prospects appear on the horizon.

Applicants must have good sense of humor and be able to distinguish between nagging (her complaints) and constructive criticism (his complaints).

Once accepted, successful applicant must be able to produce a notarized certificate of sanity issued by a qualified psychiatrist so that she may later not plead that she must have been out of her mind when taking up the position.

**You can reduce the odds**

Parents can avoid many birth related defects through sensible living habits. You should take these precautions:

1. Stick to a well balanced diet with lots of fresh fruits and vegetables.
2. Avoid excessive use of alcohol and non medical drugs.
3. Cut down or cut out smoking.
4. Ask your doctor to make sure you both have compatible blood types.
5. Notify your doctor of any family history of retardation or other medical problems on both sides.
6. Be sure you are immunized against German measles.
7. Avoid excessive exposure to X-Rays.
8. Get your doctor's approval before taking drugs or medication and take only what is necessary.
9. Visit your doctor regularly... and take his advice.
10. Insist that your baby be given a P.K.U. test before leaving the hospital. It could mean preventing retardation before it occurs.
