# Penner named to panel

According to a Report From Parliament, Cochrane-Superior MP Keith Penner, who represents the Terrace Bay-Schreiber area, was recently named as a member of the Panel of Legislative Committee Chairmen.

A total of 21 members were selected to serve on the Panel by the Speaker of the House of Commons, John Bosley. Penner will be one of four Liberals in the group, along with 13 Conservatives, three NDP members, and one independent.

Under a new Parliamentary procedure, once a bill has received second reading in the House of Commons, the Speaker appoints a member of the Panel to chair a committee

to study the bill clause by clause and hear witnesses. Once a bill is referred back to the House for its third reading, that particular committee is dissolved.

AT the moment, Penner is chairman of the Legislative Committee studying Bill C-65, an Act to amend the RCMP Act.

Besides his responsibilities on the Panel, Penner is continuing his fight to have fair representation from Northern Ontario in the House of Commons.

"The people of the north, in so many ways, regard themselves as being like a province," Penner said recently in the House. "Anyone who knows the spirit of northern Ontario knows that the people feel very much as though they

are a province."

Although northern Ontario residents, in Penner's opinion, have come to see the importance of federalism, their representation in Parliament has decreased over the years with the loss of federal ridings.

"Because it is the domi-

nant part of the province, northern Ontario requires special protection under the Electoral Boundaries Readjustment Act so that eventually we are not left with only three or four seats under redistribution," Penner explained. "That is why we are making a plea for northern Ontario as a special case."

Penner's Report From Parliament, which was distributed to constituents in his riding late last month, included a New

Year's message.

"Perhaps it would be foolish to look toward 1986 with optimism," he said in the message. "But hope springs eternal and we all hope that the New Year will be much better than 1985. Above all we hope that 1986 will be a year of peace."

He added that he hopes there will be a greater measure of prosperity to be shared by all this year. "All the best for '86," he concluded.

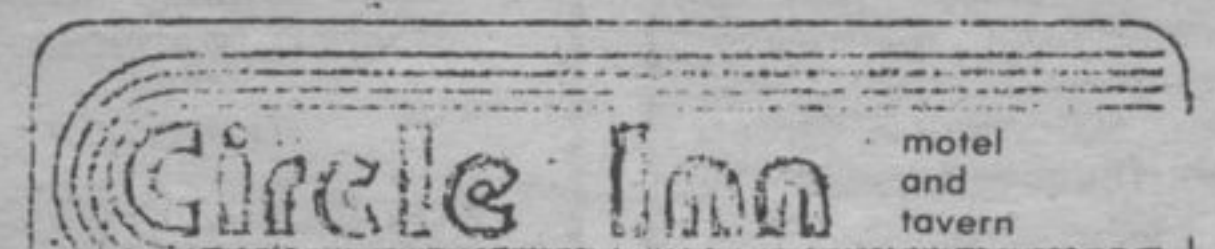
