Chapman on committee

Terrace Bay Reeve Ollie Chapman is one of seven people on a Selection Committee which has been established to choose the final list of nominations for the Northwestern Ontario Sports Hall of Fame, according to a recent news release.

Nominations for 1986 Honoured Athletes and Builders to be inducted in-

to the Hall of Fame will be received up until March 31, organization officials announced, with the final election of nominees to take place this May.

To qualify as a nominee for election as an Honoured Member of the Sports Hall of Fame, one must be a Canadian Citizen and a resident of Northwestern Ontario during that time

the nominee developed the skills which led to distinction as an athlete or builder.

A nominee in the athlete category is not normally considered until after a three year waiting period following retirement from major competition, or the performance of a particular achievement, the release pointed out.

A builder may be active or inactive, the release added. Any Northwestern Ontario team that has won a national or international competition and has distinguished itself as a representative of Canada is also eligible for election.

Nominations should be sent along with a complete resume of the nominee's sports accomplishments, including dates and venues. In the event the nominee is selected, it is expected the nominator will assist in

procuring pictures of the candidate if he or she is deceased.

The Selection Committee charged with the responsibility of making the selections based on the information provided with the nominations consist of the following individuals besides Reeve Chapman: Cliff Bowles of Thunder Bay, Glen Steele of Fort Frances, Edgar Laprade, Ted Murphy and Sandy Sargent of Thunder Bay, Bill Salonen of Dryden.

Rob McCormack is the President of the group, which is a member of the Canadian Association for Sports Heritage.
