probably help to reduce the traffic safety problem.

"We told them that things have changed there since their last study," Reeve Chapman said after the meeting. The last MTC study of the area took place in 1981. "We did look at

different alternatives, and I'll remain optimistic that something can be done."

Boucher and Adams were even taken to the site in person by Baker to have a firsthand look at the difficulties there, she added. One other possibility that

was ruled out at the meeting was the addition of two extra lanes to make the highway four lanes wide at that spot.

"That is just not possible," Reeve Chapman explained. A single turning lane could be put in, though.

## Register your ORV

This is a notice from the Terrace Bay Police Force:

An off road vehicle is any two, three, or four wheeled motorized vehicle plus specific vehicles with more wheels designed primarily for recreational use.

Those licensed for on-road use, or exempt by regulation are not included.

All off road vehicles must be registered and the one time Registration Fee is \$25. When a vehicle registered as an off road vehicle is driven on a highway, the Highway Traffic Act offences will apply.

Insurance: Vehicle Liability Insurance is required for all off-road vehicles being driven anywhere other than on land owned or occupied by the vehicle owner. Proof of insurance must be carried by the driver.

Helmets that meet the motorcycle's helmet regulations must be worn by drivers, passengers, and riders on a conveyance towed by an off road vehicle.

Collisions must be reported to the Police im-

mediately if it results in an injury or damage to property that apparently exceeds \$700.

This information is provided for those residents who have purchased or are planning to purchase an off road vehicle.
