Secretary, read the minutes of the last meeting and the letters that were received. Mrs. Bern Jacomb, card secretary, read cards of get well and bereaved.

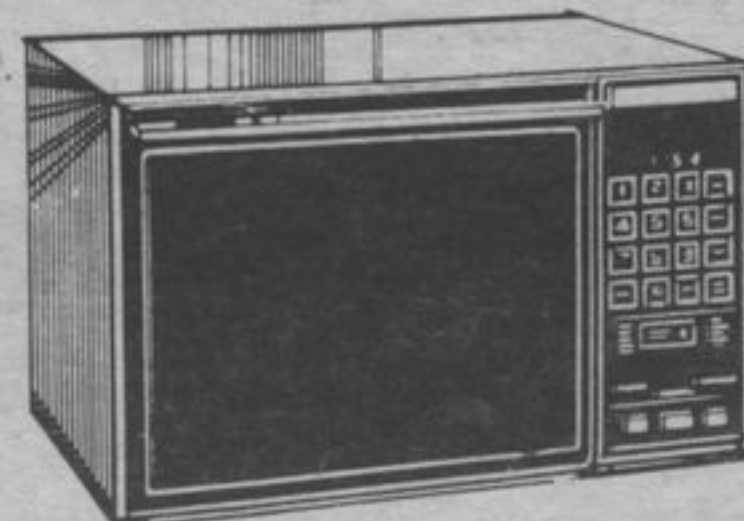

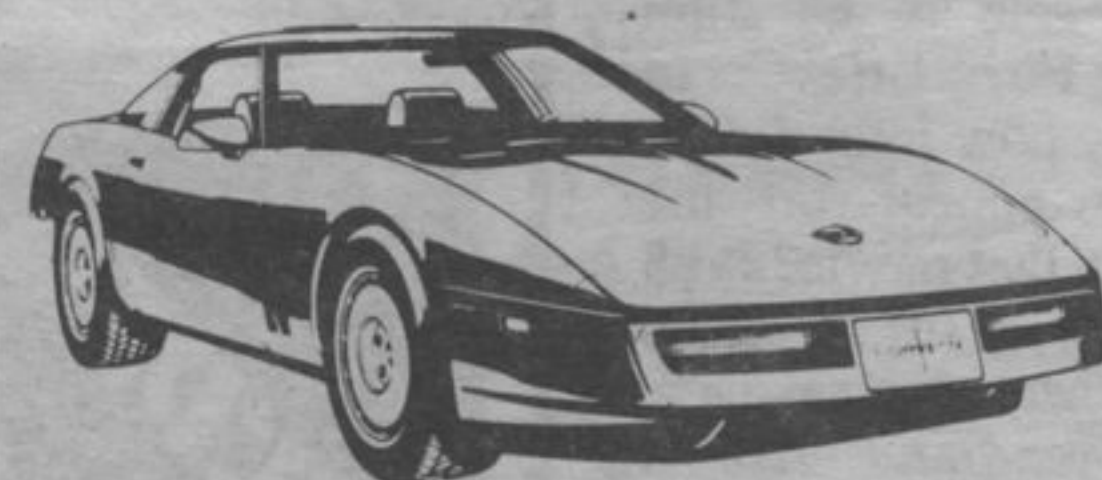
