## Police Force in Terrace bay kept busy all week

Over the past two weeks the Terrace Bay Police Force investigated four motor vehicle accidents, according to a news release dated May 2.

Three of the mishaps involved damages over \$700 each, and one was a hit and run accident. No other details were included in the news report.

One car was also reported stolen over the

past week. It was stolen from the Recreation Centre area, and was located the following day abandoned near the town airport.

The Police Force also received a report of a stolen snow machine, which was later discovered abandoned in the bush and subsequently returned to its owner. Police are still investigating a theft involving a compressor stolen from a resi-

dent's backyard storage shed. Another theft from a resident's yard was reported and the stolen item later found by its owner.

As a result of a complaint regarding a vehicle driving irratically in the new subdivision, one Schreiber resident was charged with careless driving under the Highway Traffic Act, the release noted.

One complaint of property damage was investigated by police at a local garage. In other police matters, officers were called to the McCausland Hospital recently to assist with an unstable patient, remaining on the scene until all was under control.

A male subject wanted by Terrace Bay Police was

picked up in Thunder Bay. As a result, the local Force's warrant was sent to Thunder Bay for proceedings against the accused being held by Thunder Bay Police. Town officers also investigated several parking complaints, resulting in some warnings and several tickets being issued.

Two complaints were received of suspicious individuals and vehicles from out of town. One transient was assisted on his way out of Terrace Bay and the other could not be located and later was found to have left the municipality on his own. A local woman was

picked up by police after damaging a hydro pole with her vehicle and causing a disturbance. Afterwards, this person was lodged in the Schreiber OPP cells, charged with dangerous driving under the Criminal Code and transferred to Thunder Bay for psychiatric treatment.

The police report noted that a complaint was received from a local resident regarding threats made against his daughter recently. This matter is still under investigation pending positive identification of the

suspected Young Offender.

A check on a local person resulted in a liquor seizure and a charge of being intoxicated in a public place under the Liquor Licence Act. A report of a suspected impaired driver on Highway 17 was forwarded to the OPP detachment in Marathon for their investigation.

complaint of fraud which was later reported as unfounded and no further action required. One complaint was received regarding youth trespassing on private property. Appropriate warnings were issued by police. One abandoned vehicle was reported and towed away to the dump by the Township crew.

## Program ready

Operation Bicycle Identification is a program that is intended to deter bicycle thefts, and is expected to begin next week, a Terrace Bay Police Force news release has announced.

Should a bicycle be lost or stolen, the program will also aid in returning the bike to its rightful owner, the release added.

The program consists of a registration form which will record the name, address, and telephone number of the owner plus the bicycle make, model, and serial number, which will correspond to an adhesive tamper-proof sticker which will be attached to the bike.

In the event that a bicycle does not have a serial number, the owner's Social Insurance Number will be stamped on the vehicle instead. This number will serve as a unique number for identification purposes, the release pointed out.


