Penner praises CT Commission

Cochrane-Superior MP Keith Penner has commended the Canadian Transport Commission (CTC) for their report on derailments and collisions in a recent news release. It is noted in the report that both Canadian National (CN) and Canadian Pacific (CP) have been reducing managerial and supervisory staff less rapidly than the

workforce as a whole. "There is a great deal wrong with Canada's Railway systems," Penner said. "Obviously one problem is that we have too many paper pushers and not enough rail employees looking after roadbeds, tracks and rolling stock. At last the CTC has caught up with common knowledge," he added.
