The 3,000 kilometre Bike Ride for Kids will come through the Terrace Bay area around June 17, the letter, from campaign director Doris J. Wagner added.

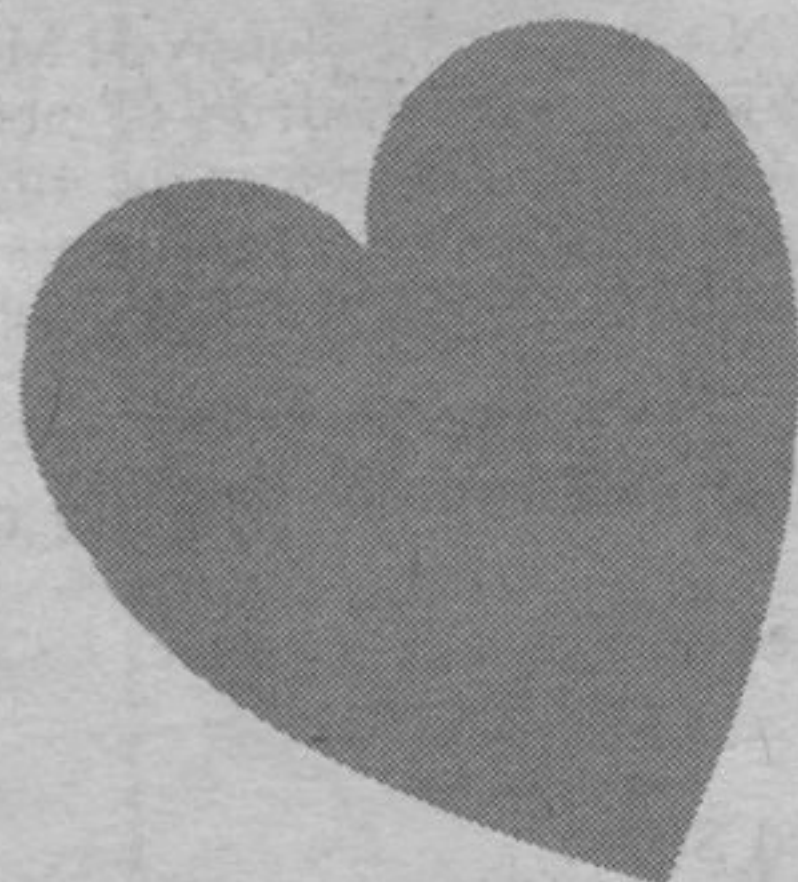
Ken Soney is planning to raise \$25,000, which will go towards the construction of an arena and community centre on the reserve, located near Wallaceburg.
