

Canada Day weekend dance to be held in Schreiber

The township of Schreiber will be celebrating the Canada Day weekend with a number of events, including a dance to be held on Saturday, June 28, which will feature the band Black on White, known for its Top 40 renditions.

The Kinsmen are planning a big Family Day at White Sand Lake on Canada Day, July 1, according to a Recreation Department news release. The event will begin at 10 a.m.

This year the Kinsmen have added two canoe

racers, with the first one a simple out-and-around the marker and back. Prizes have been donated by Spadoni's, Schreiber Foodmarket, and Birch's. There is no limit and no entry fee for the race.

The second race will involve a relay, with two running sections and a canoeing section. There must be at least one member of the opposite sex included in each four member team (i.e. a minimum of one woman on a team with three men, or at least

one man along with up to three women on another).

Entry is limited to 10 teams and a small entry fee will be charged. The prize for this event is dinner for eight at the Rosspoint Inn. There will also be child-

ren's races and other exciting attractions. Plan to attend, and bring the whole family.

Dear Editor:

Due to the surge in publicity for organizations and issues connected with drinking and driving, and in this season of graduation parties, Toc Alpha, a youth organization with 600 members in Ontario, has developed its own position on this issue.

We commend groups which have initiated ways

of preventing the consequences of drinking and driving, i.e. buses hired for graduation, designated driver programmes and parent / student drinking driving contracts. These measures are making a difference; most importantly they are saving lives.

However, these are safeguard measures only and the underlying issue of

teenage drinking is not being questioned. For all these good intentions it still must be recognized that under-aged drinking is illegal. By removing the consequences a teenager must face when drinking, adult leaders may be giving a message that they sanction teenage drinking, or that any amount of drinking is acceptable as long as you stay off the roads.

Toc Alpha believes that drinking/driving contracts and other safety measures are a means of opening up channels to communication between teens and adults with regard to drinking and driving.

We feel that the real problem is not just drinking and driving, but in the decision making process involved in drinking behaviour.

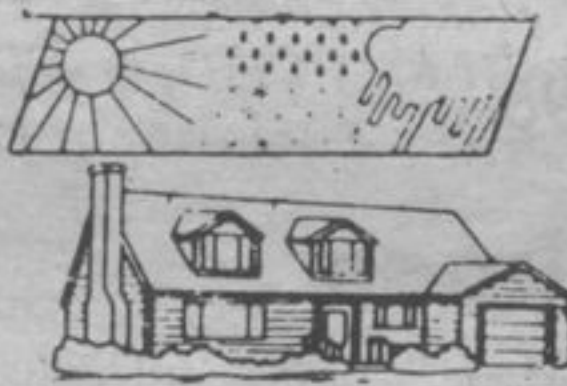
