Bike safety program on

The Easter Seal Society of Ontario is concerned about the number of cycling injuries and deaths among young Canadian cyclists, according to a recent Society news release.

In response to this problem, the program called 'Be Bike Smart' is being actively promoted by the Society to reduce the number of disabling and fatal bicycle accidents, the release from the Society's Public Relations Officer Marlene Cullen in Toronto added.

Canada has 8 million cyclists and more than 3 million of them are children. A study conducted at

Toronto's Hospital for Sick Children noted that 28 per cent of all trauma deaths during the period from June of 1984 to December, 1985 were the result of bi-

cycling accidents. However, the release did add that the advantages of cycling as a physical activity greatly outweigh the risks involved. Children can learn the proper use and care of their bikes and the importance of wearing protective gear.

The Easter Seal Society is a charitable organization speaking and acting on behalf of 6,800 physically challenged youngsters and their families.

It was formed in 1922 by 10 service clubs and today that volunteer base has grown to 235 affiliated

clubs across the province. Four major sources fund the Society's efforts: the annual Easter Seal campaign including local fundraising events, direct mail campaigns, bequests, and various fund-raising activities including Snowarama and Superthon.

Revenue Canada Taxation announced early this month that the interest rate on overdue and overpaid taxes for the next quarter will be 10 per cent, down from the 11 per cent rate in effect since April 1, 1986.

According to a government news release, the new interest rate applies to all refunds for overpayments as well as all overdue taxes, insufficient instalment payments and unpaid employee tax deductions.

This rate also applies to upaid Canada Pension Plan contributions and Unemployment insurance premiums.

The 10 per cent rate is also the prescribed rate for calculating the taxable benefit to employees and shareholders from interestfree and low-interest loans during the period July 1 to September 30, 1986.
