will recognize the DAG as a co-group with the Chronic Unit in their future considerations.

A list of concerns to be addressed in the future was compiled. A request was made to have Cathy Smith, Resources Officer, attend a meeting to give us information and guidance. The March of Dimes representative, Linda Cairns, will also be contacted for information regarding financial help available for the purchase of communication aids for the disabled.

Terrace Bay Council has indicated its willingness to meet with DAG on August 28 to discuss snow removal and accessibility to buildings in town. Schreiber Council will be invited to

send representatives as well and co-ordinate assistance where needed for the disabled.


