*Photography*: Do you own a 35 mm camera or are you thinking of

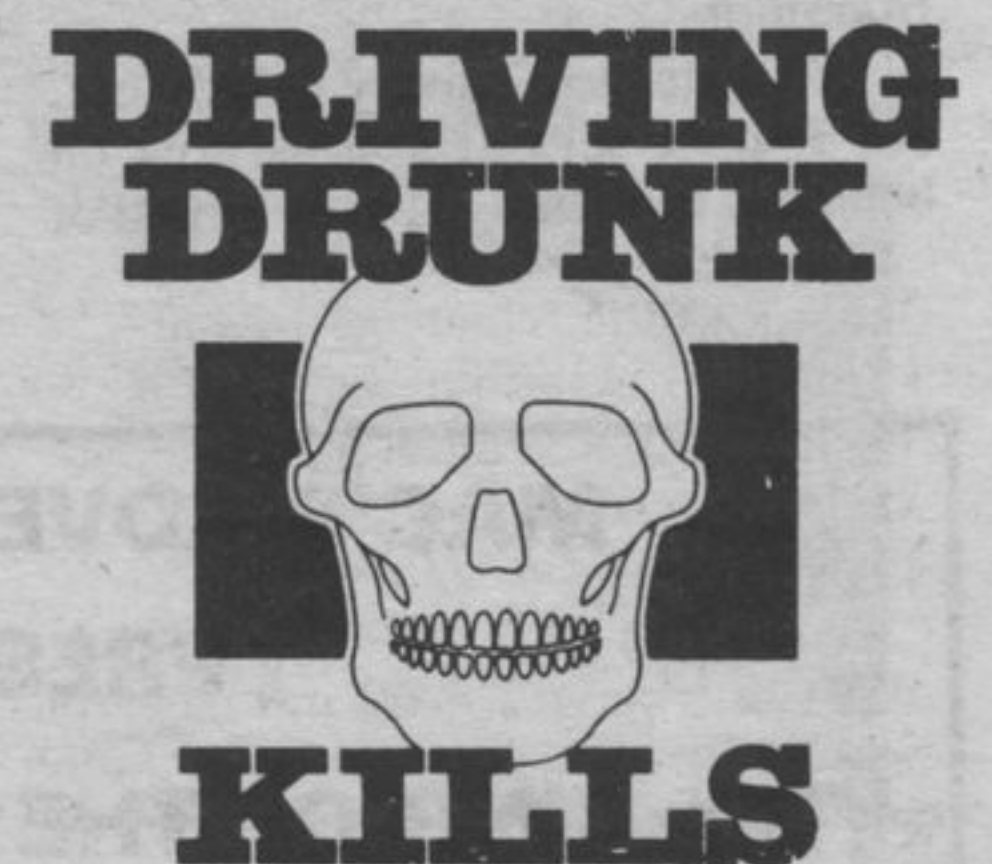
