Two Class Environmental Assessments have been submitted by Ontario Hydro to seek approval for:

a) shoreline and riverbank improvement projects b) modifications to hydroelectric facilities.

The Ministry of the Environment has now completed the Reviews of the Class Environmental Assessments prepared and submitted by Ontario Hydro.

The Minister of the Environment has given a Notice of Receipt of the Environmental Assessment and Completion of Environmental Assessment Review dated January 27, 1987.

The projects which are subject to the planning procedures described in the Class Environmental Assessments could occur on any lakes and rivers in Ontario, which may be affected by existing hydroelectric generation facilities and at any existing hydroelectric generation facility in Ontario.

Copies of the Notice, the Class Environmental Assessments and the Reviews are available for

inspection at all Ministry of the Environment Regional Offices, the Environmental Assessment Branch of the Ministry of the Environment and at Ontario Hydro Regional Offices. Copies of the Review and Notice are also available at all Ministry of Northern Development and Mines area offices. Submissions to the Minister of the Environment concerning the shoreline and riverbank improvement projects or the modifications to hydroelectric facilities and requests for hearings must be received by the Minister by January 27, 1987.

Only those persons who submit written comments and/or requests for a hearing will have the opportunity to request a hearing at a later date should the Environmental Assessments for the two undertakings be accepted without hearings.


