

Nominate someone for Sports Hall of Fame

The Northwestern Ontario Sports Hall of Fame invites sports groups and the general public to submit to its Induction Selection Committee the names of persons or teams that have contributed to the sports heritage of Northwestern Ontario.

Qualifications

To qualify as a nominee for election as an Honoured Member to the Northwestern Ontario Sports Hall of Fame, an athlete, builder or team must meet the following conditions:

General:

1) A nominee must be a Canadian Citizen and either born in Northwestern Ontario or a resident of Northwestern Ontario during the period of time that the nominee developed the skills that

led to the distinction as an athlete or builder.

Athlete:

1) Must fall within one of the two following categories:

a) one who has performed as a professional
b) an amateur who has competed at the local, provincial, national or international level

2) Not normally considered until after a three-year waiting period following either:

a) retirement from major competition or
b) the performance of a particularly outstanding achievement.

Builder:

1) A person, other than an athlete, who has meritoriously served in the field of sport in a capacity such as an

executive, a game official, a coach, a trainer or a comparable position for a period of not less than ten years, although such period need not necessarily be consecutive.

2) Candidates may be either active or inactive at the time of their consideration.

Teams:

Any Northwestern Ontario Team that has won a National Championship

or that has distinguished itself in International competition as a team duly selected to represent Canada in such competition.

Nominating Procedure

Nominations must be submitted to the Sports Hall of Fame, 435 Balmoral St., before February 28, 1987.

The nomination should include all relevant data pertaining to the nominee.
