Special Note: Please stay off the ball field until official notice has been given that all work has been completed.

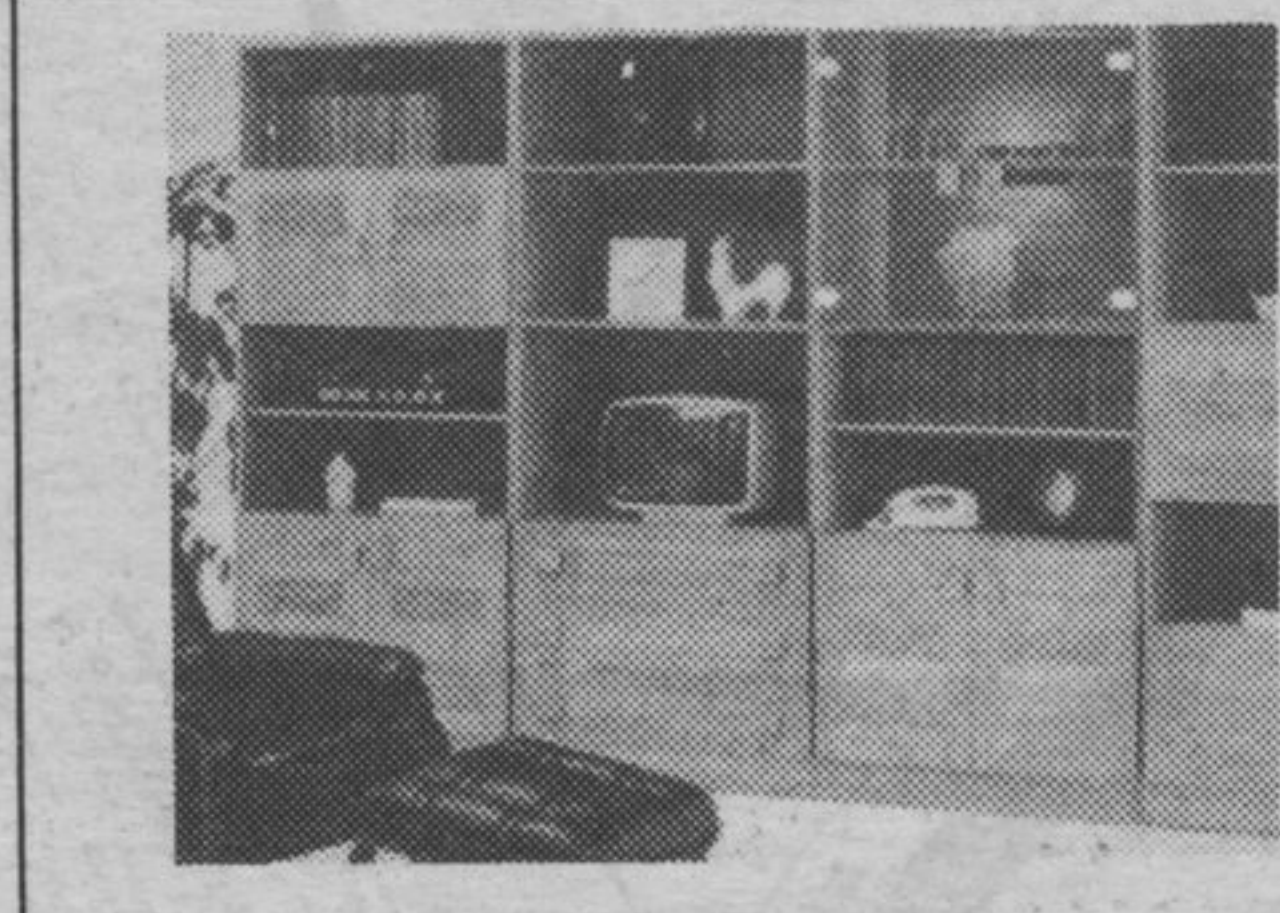
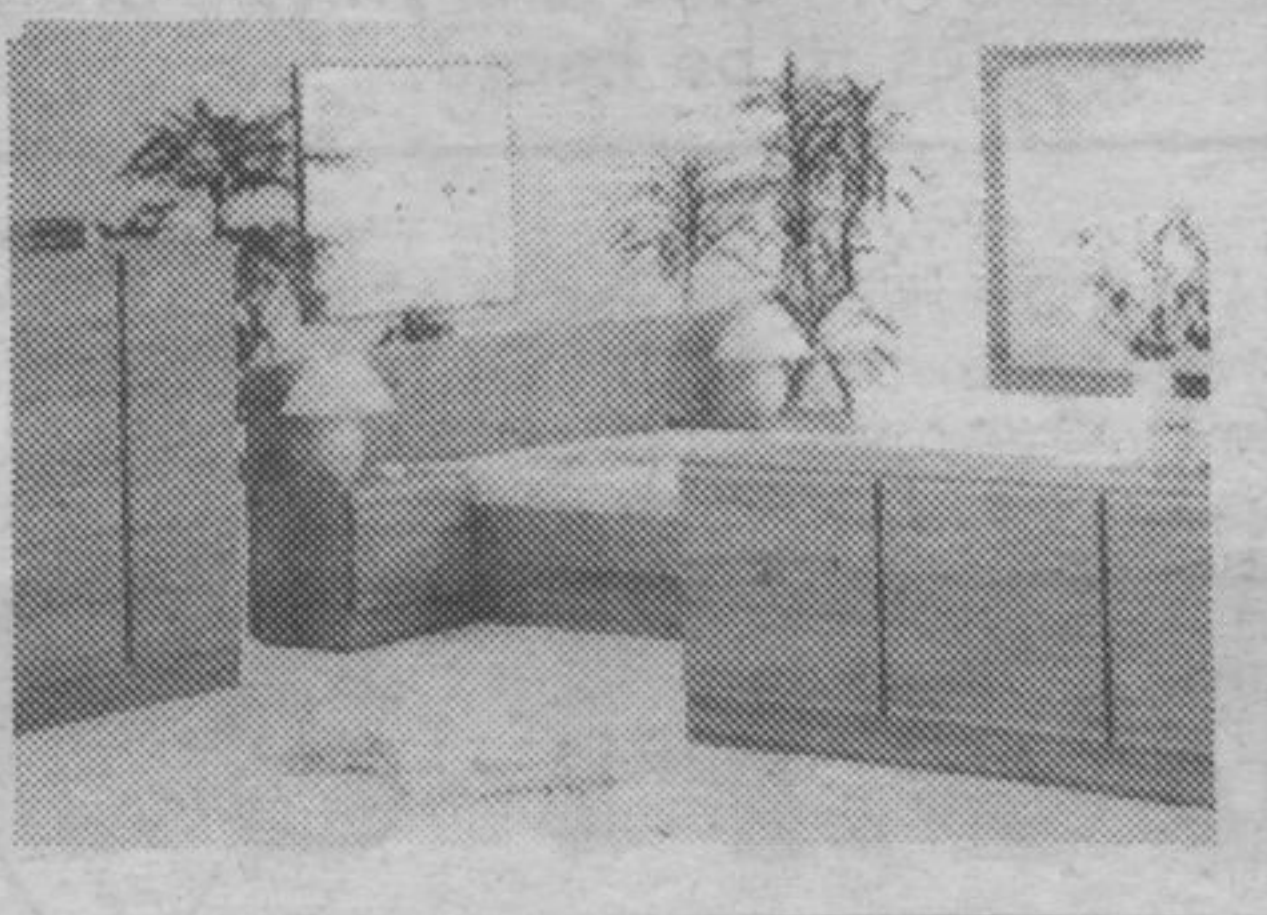
