

Spruce budworm spraying to begin on May 15

Beginning May 15, more than 79,000 hectares of spruce budworm-infected forest will be aerial sprayed with the biological insecticide *Bacillus thuringiensis* (B.t.) in the ministry's North Central administrative region, Regional Budworm Co-ordinator Roy Klein announced.

"The largest project will take place in the Black

Sturgeon Lake area, about 130 kilometres from Thunder Bay in the southwest corner of Nipigon district, where 38,000 hectares will be sprayed," he said.

Another 25,600 hectares will be sprayed in the Thunder Bay and Nipigon Districts combined, including 130 hectares in Sibley Provincial Park.

Terrace Bay and Geraldton districts will spray a total area of 7,900 hectares, and Thunder Bay District will spray 8,100 hectares in two provincial parks on behalf of the Northwestern administrative region.

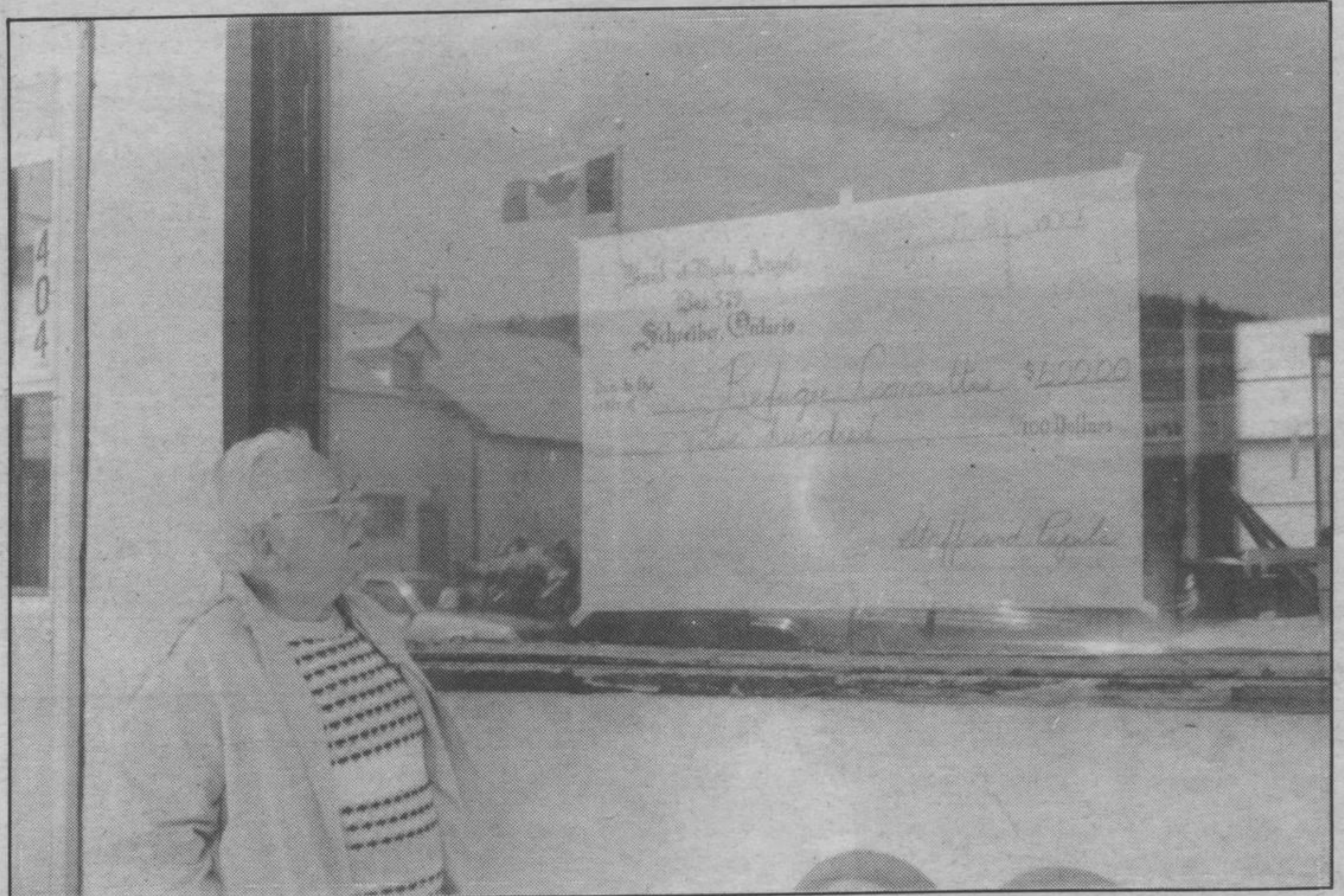
"This year's program is considerably smaller than in 1986," Mr. Klein explained. "And due to a collapse in the jack pine budworm population, it is not necessary to spray for this pest in 1987."

Last year, more than 99,000 hectares of forest were sprayed for the spruce budworm and almost 32,000 hectares of forest were sprayed for the jack pine budworm in North Central Region.
