KENNEDY - Mr. Joseph Alban Kennedy, aged 64 years of Terrace Bay passed away in hospital on Tuesday, May 5, 1987. He was born February 23, 1923 in Fort William. He enlisted in the Navy in 1941 and served on board the HMCS Algoma. Former member of the Terrace Bay Separate School Board and was elected Diocesan Separate School Trustee for Thunder Bay District. Former member of the Terrace Bay Council, he was active with the Liberal Party in Terrace Bay and a member of St. Martin's Parish. Formerly employed with Kimber-Clark for 35 years. Survived by his wife, Mary-Clare; sons Jerald and wife Lori of Mississauga; Patrick and Carol of Sardis, B.C.; Kenneth and Helle of Dragor, Denmark; James of Edmonton; Richard and Sui of Vancouver; Joseph of Terrace Bay; daughters, Linda of Vancouver; Mary-Jo and husband Guy Mageau of Terrace Bay; Carol and Michael Koshowski of Terrace Bay; Dorothy of Edmonton; also survived by his mother Gertrude of Ottawa, sisters, Mary and brother-in-law Niel Hinsperger of Mississauga; Ruth and Herb Linke of Ottawa; brother Bart and Judy of Boston, Mass.
