The closure will result in the loss of 101 jobs- this includes 59 hourly sawmill employees, four salaried employees and 38 woodlands workers.

Lavallet said at the meeting that the sawmill business and the sawmill operations have been analyzed and it showed that there will not be a reasonable rate of return in the future to ensure K-C's primary objective- quality pulp.

Both the company and the union agree that the 15 per cent softwood lumber duty on exports to the U.S. was a factor to the closure.


