Top Guns: GP- 4; W- 2; L- 1; T- 1; PTS- 5; A-Team: GP- 3;

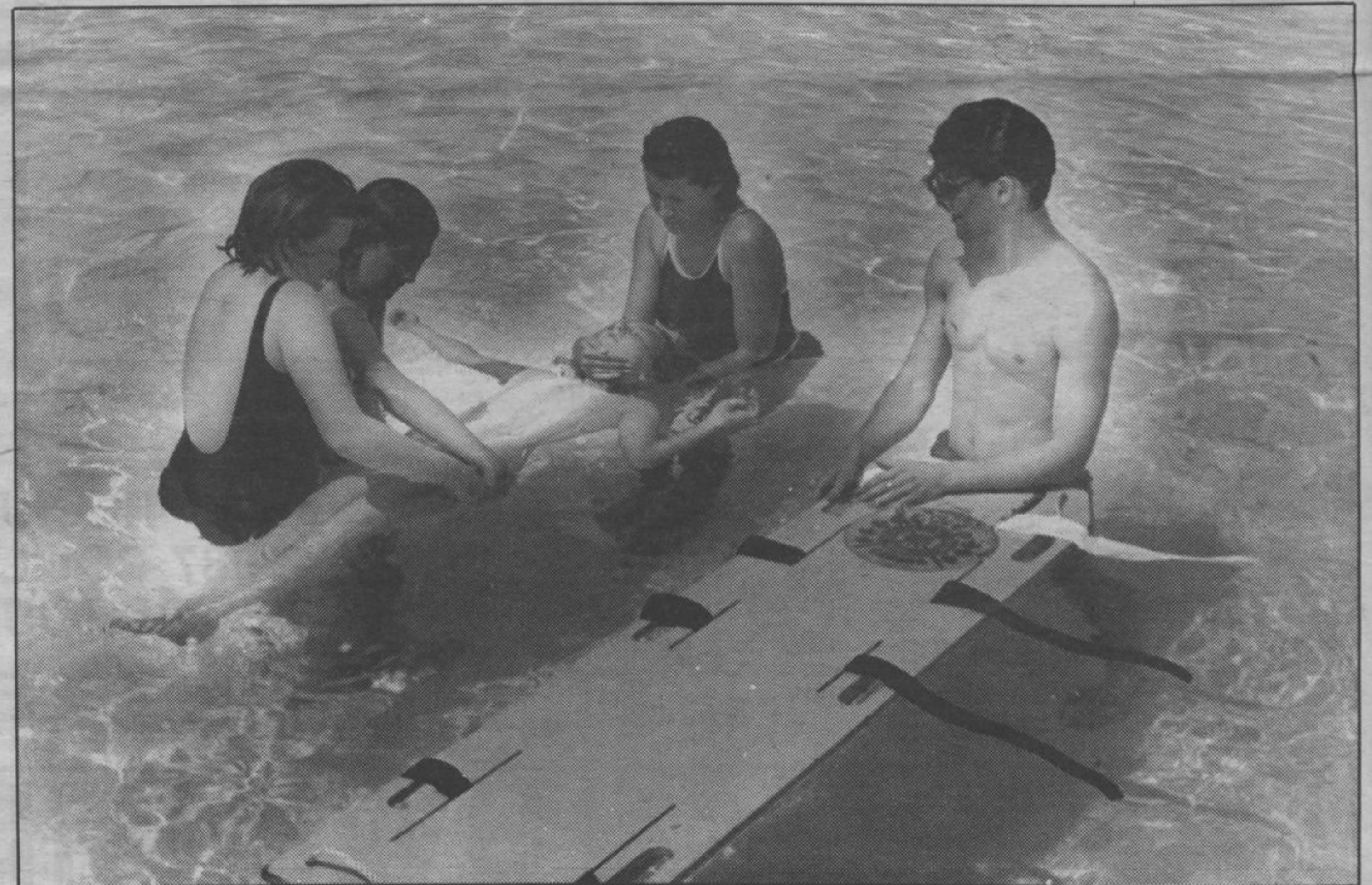
