The truck hero will receive these awards at the Ontario Trucking Association Convention being held in Toronto on November 25, 26 and 27, 1987.

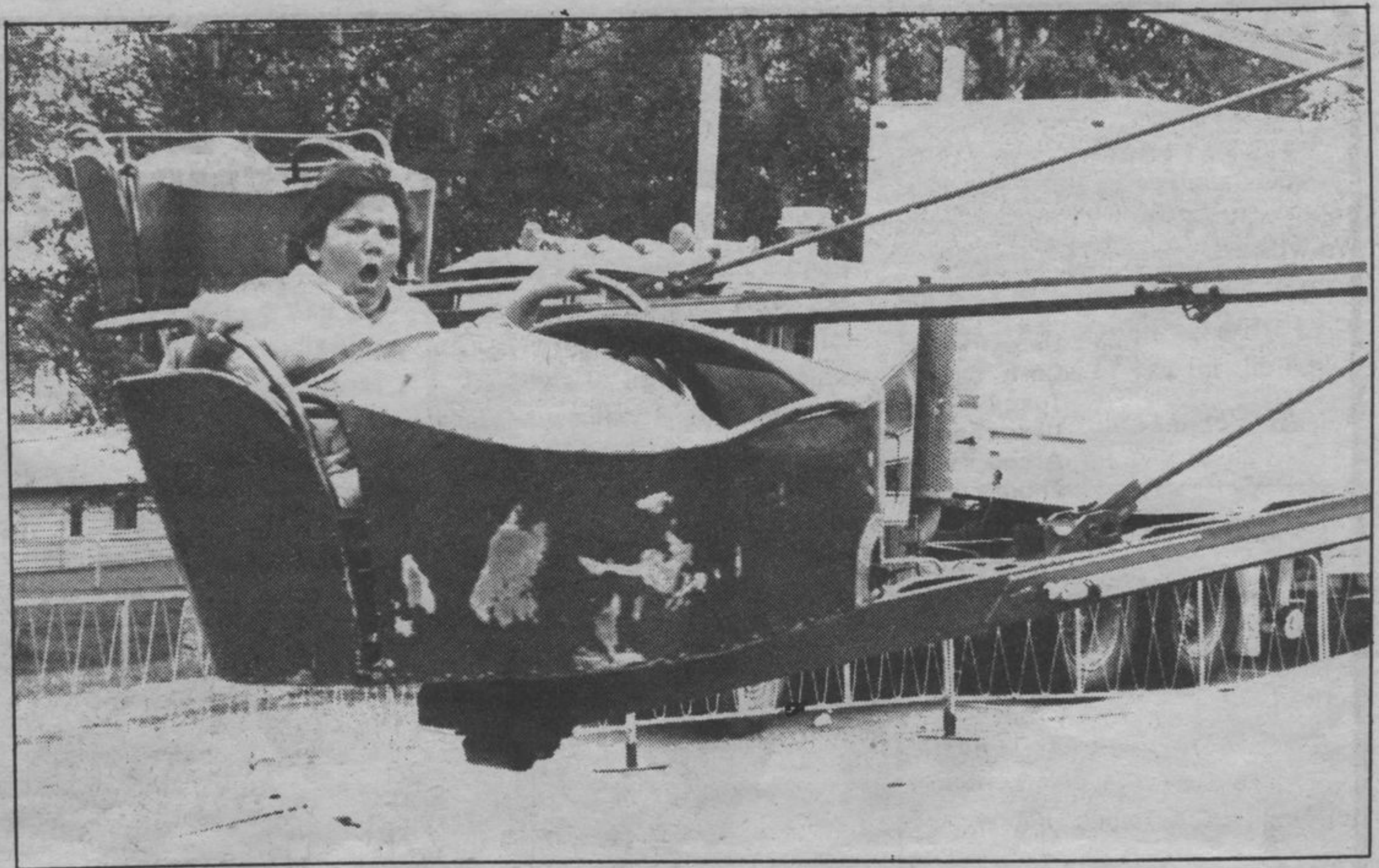

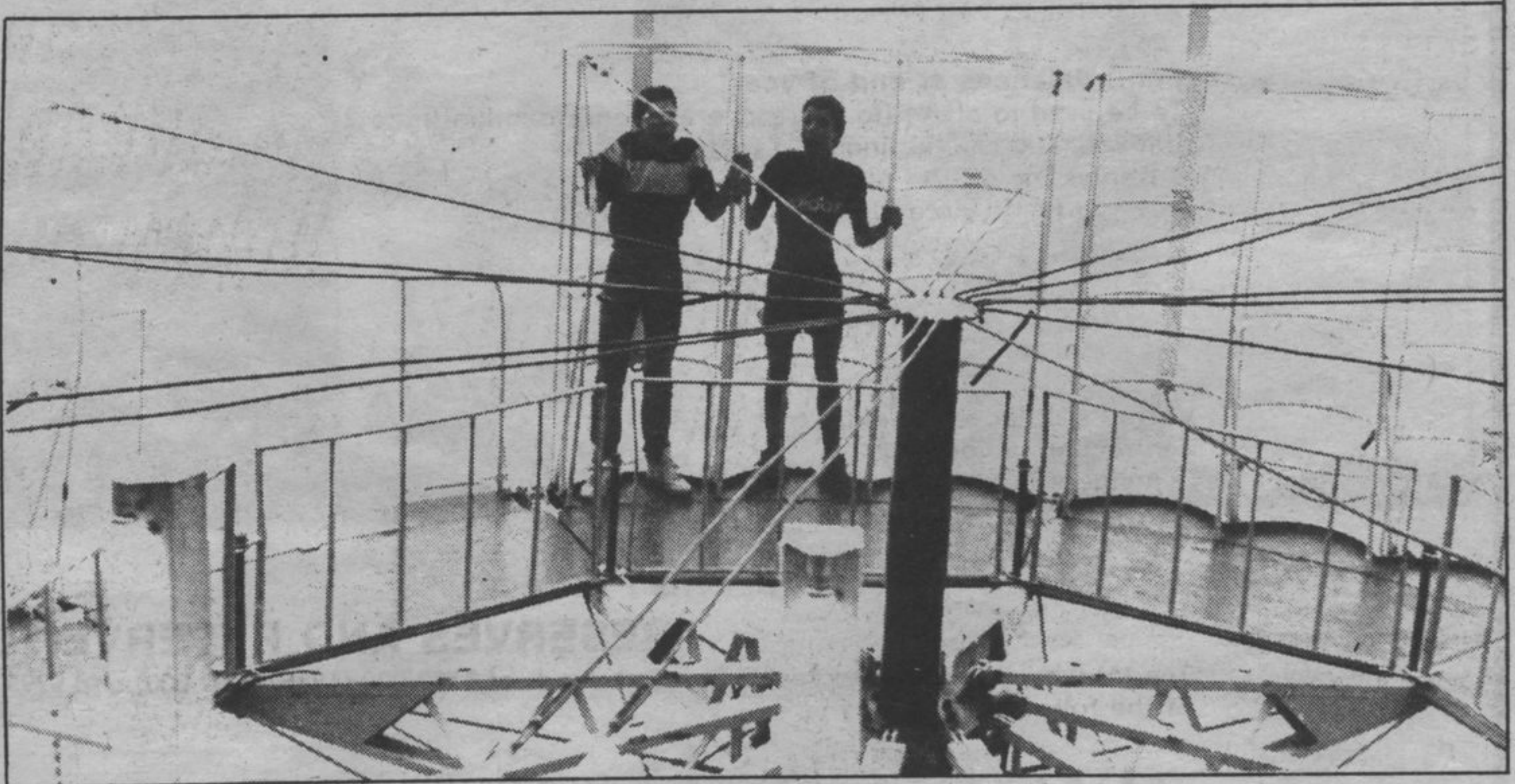
Firestone will pay the winner's nominator \$200. The act of bravery must be performed during the year ending September 30, 1987, by a Canadian professional truck driver in Canada.

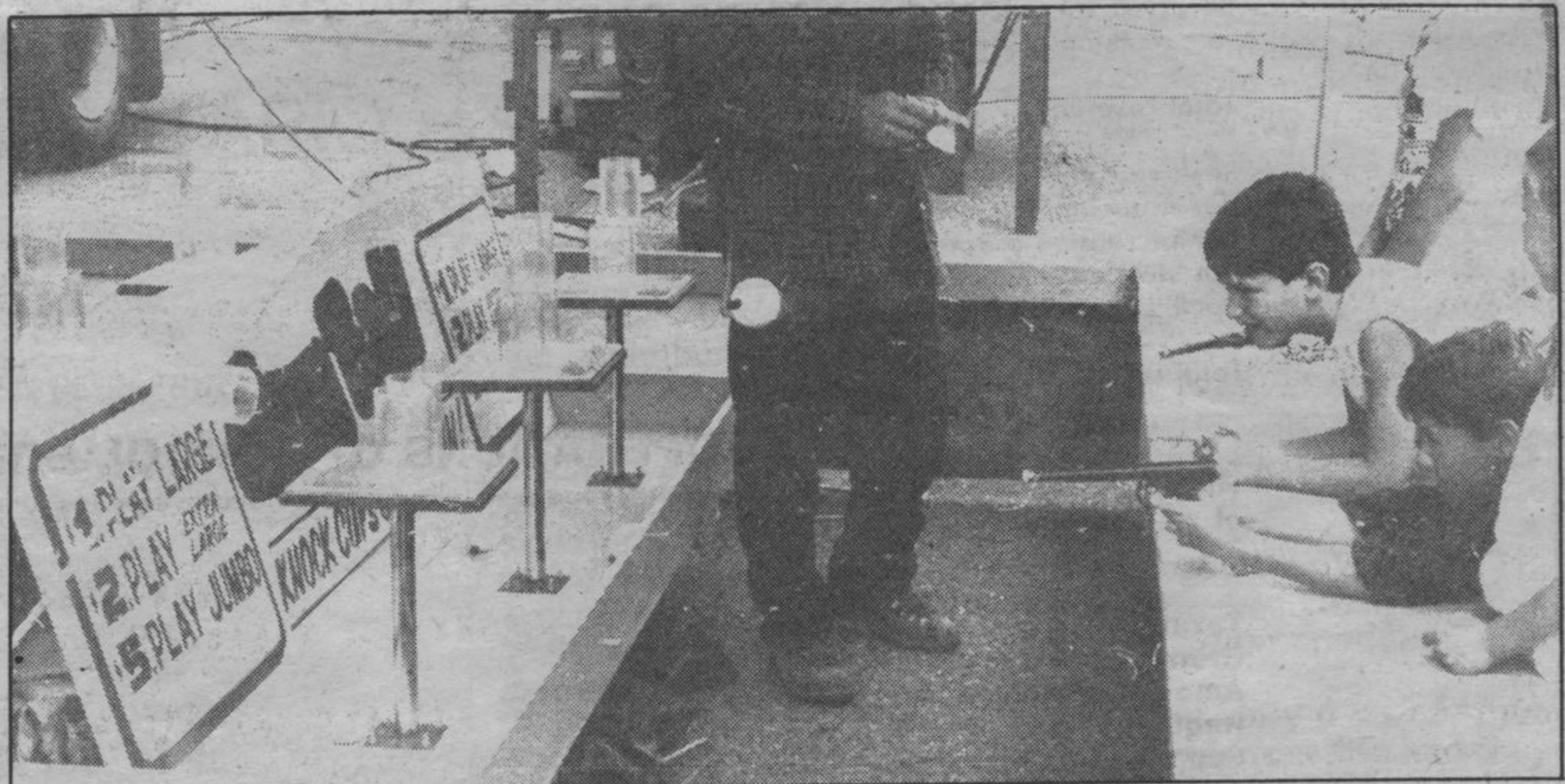

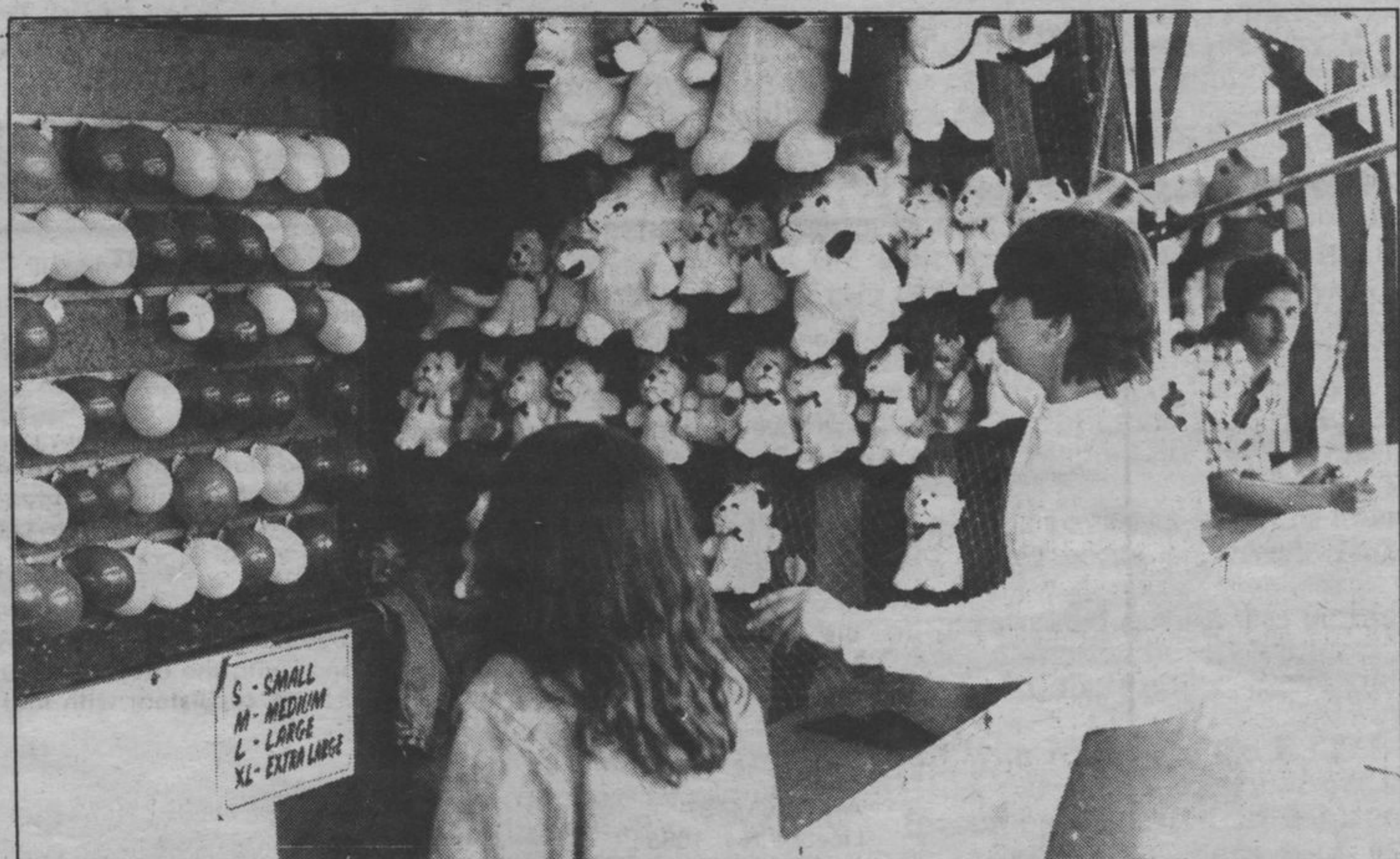
