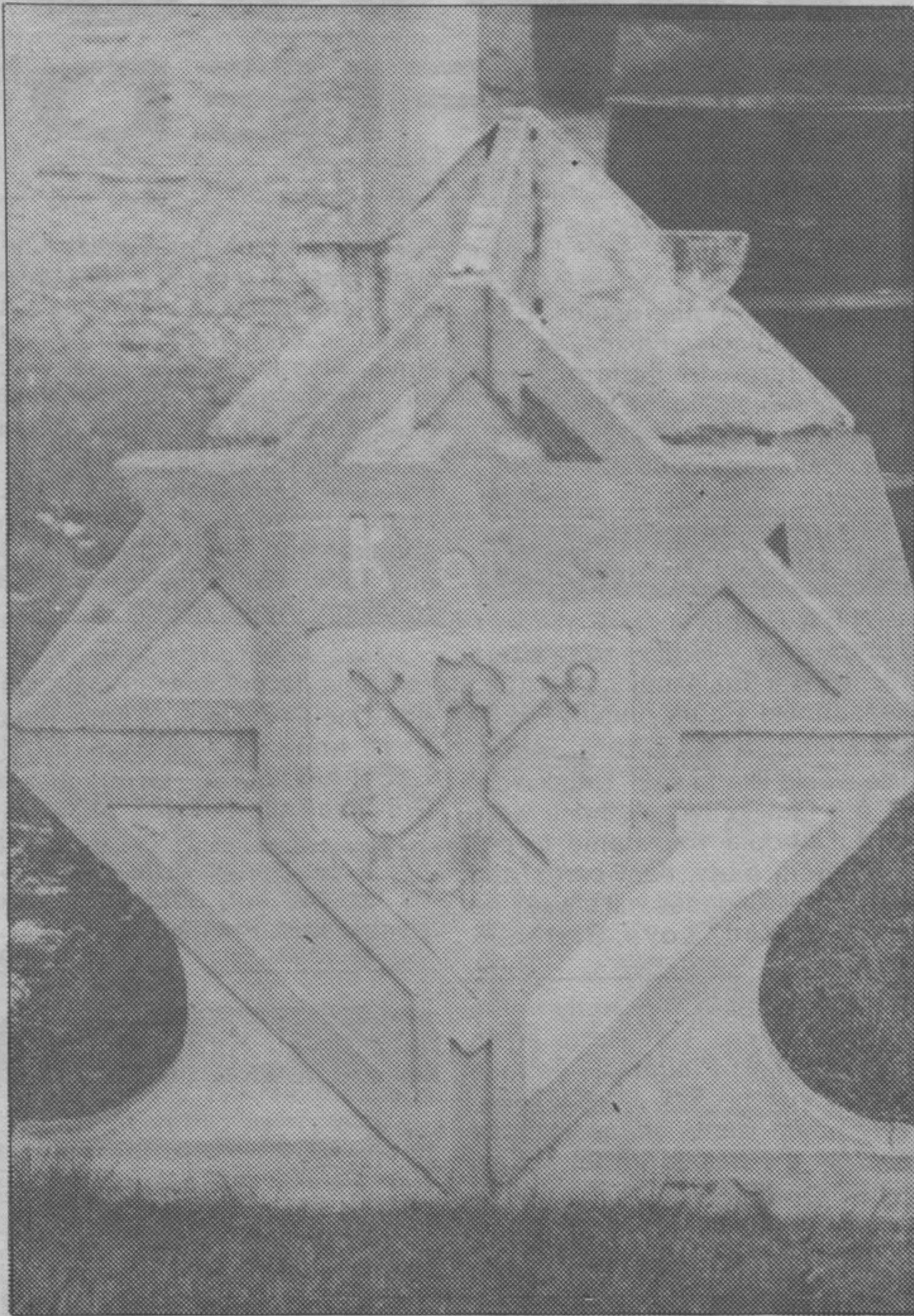


Terrace Bay Recreation

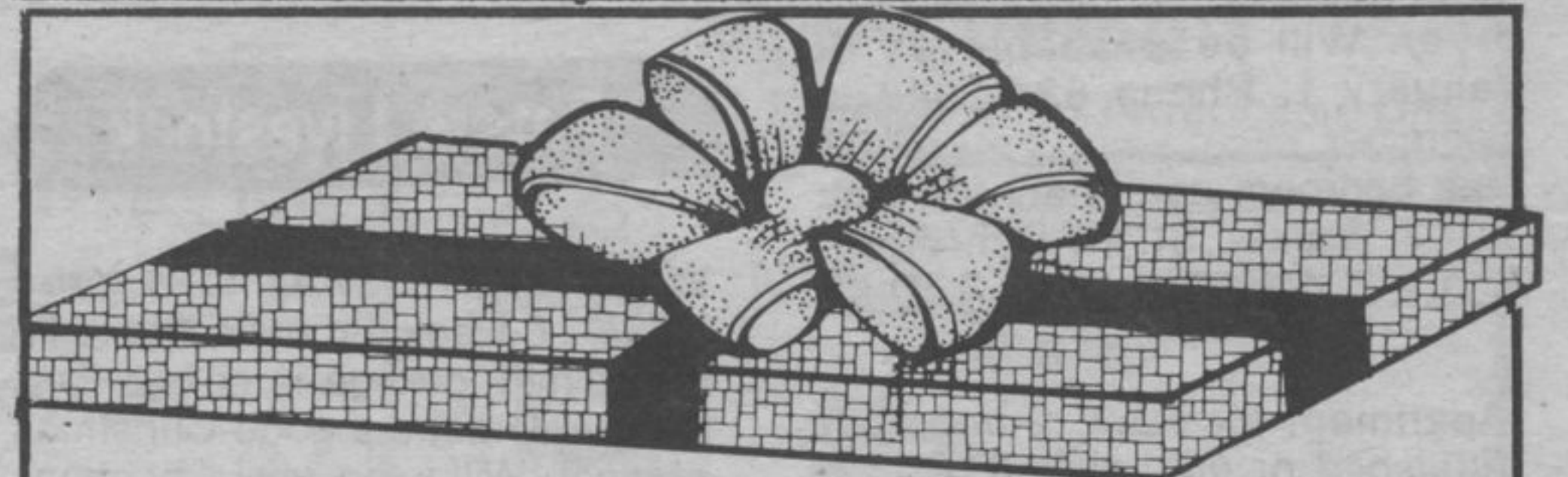
